

Spanish II Syllabus

Course Description/Goals:

Spanish II is a continuation of exploring the language and culture of Spanish speaking countries. In this course, students will express meaning in straightforward and personal contexts by combining and recombining what they know, what they read, and what they hear in short statements and sentences. They are able to understand information from simple connected statements in oral or written sources. Students will communicate in presentations, interpersonally, and interpretively. Students in Spanish II are expected to reach a *novice high* to *intermediate low* level of language proficiency at completion of study.
