Student Requirements**

Picture Identification: School student ID card and/or a valid government photo ID.

Writing Tools: Several sharpened #2 pencils with erasers and black or dark blue ink pens

Calculators: Required for math and science exams (four-function or scientific calculators; graphing calculators are required or permitted specific to Algebra/Geometry/Science guidelines). *Please note: all calculators must be checked and cleared prior to entering the exam room. Calculator covers should be left at home, or will be required to be left in a visible area in an area of the room designated by the exam proctor.*

Math Tools: Rulers for math exams and a compass if taking geometry.

Optional Items: A clear, label-free water bottle.

Prohibited Items:

- Cell phones
- iPods and MP3 players;
- iPads, tablets, and other eReaders:
- personal laptops, notebooks, or any other computing devices;
- cameras or other photographic equipment;
- wearable devices/smartwearables, including smartwatches, smartglasses, and health wearables with a display;
- headphones, headsets, or in-ear headphones, such as earbuds; and
- any other device capable of recording audio, photographic or video content, or capable of viewing or playing back such content

All personal items will be required to be turned off/turned in and left in a visible area designated by the exam proctors.

Temporary absence from the Examination Room is prohibited unless accompanied by a proctor. In order to minimize distractions, please plan accordingly and use the restroom prior to arrival.
