Terms of Agreement

In this agreement, "you" and "your" means the parent/guardian and the student enrolled in Davidson County Schools (DCS). The "equipment" is any DCS-issued device, power cord/charger, and hotspot (when applicable).

Terms:	You will be issued a DCS device and power cord/charger. You will need to comply with Davidson County Board of Education Policies* 3225/4312/7320 Technology Responsible Use, 3226/4205 Internet Safety, and all other applicable board policies. DCS uses technology protection measures to limit or restrict access to materials considered harmful or inappropriate to students. It may not be possible for DCS to absolutely prevent such access. Beyond the limits of content filtering, a student may run across some material that is objectionable.
Title:	Legal title to the equipment belongs to the district and shall at all times remain with the district. Your right to use the equipment is limited to and conditioned upon your full compliance with this Agreement, applicable board policies and any applicable handbook. Loan of the equipment to you terminates on the collection date set by the school unless terminated earlier by the district or upon the student's withdrawal from the district.
Equipment:	You must report any lost, stolen, or damaged equipment to the school immediately. For stolen equipment, you must also file a police report and provide a copy to the school. If the equipment is lost or damaged, either intentionally or due to negligence, the student may be subject to discipline and you may be responsible for repair or replacement costs.
Sanctions for Violations:	Any activity that violates school board policy, this agreement or any applicable handbook should be reported to a school administrator. Disciplinary action, if any, for the students and other users shall be consistent with the district's standard policies and procedures. Violations of school board policy, this agreement or any applicable handbook can constitute cause for revocation of access privileges, suspension of access to Davidson County Schools' electronic resources, other school disciplinary action, and/or other appropriate legal or criminal action including restitution, if appropriate. Sanctions may be imposed for violations that occur on or off school grounds.

Acceptance of Terms

By signing this form, you confirm that you understand the information in this agreement and agree to allow your student to use the internet, Google Apps for Education, including email and approved Web 2.0 tools. You also confirm that you have read, understand, and accept the terms of DCS Policies 3225/4312/7320 Technology Responsible Use, 3226/4205 Internet Safety, and all other applicable board policies. Additionally, parent/guardians must also complete the consent for Educational Technology & AI Tools, which is attached to the back of this agreement. Your signature hereby acknowledges that you may incur a fee for damage(s) to the equipment pursuant to a schedule of damages determined by the district.

Schedule of damages includes:

- \$350 in the event of vandalism, negligent care, and/or intentional damage that renders the device beyond repair.
- \$25 for the loss, theft, or damage to the power cord/supply component included with the device.
