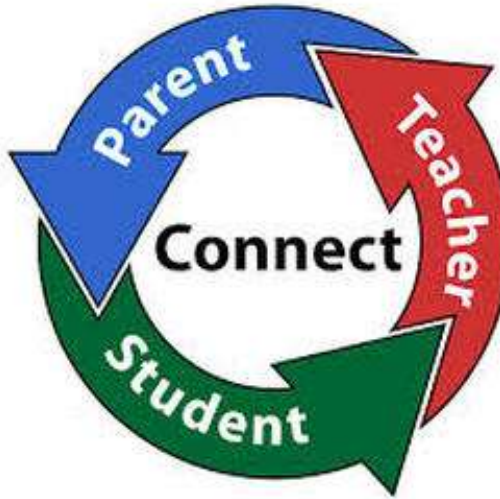
Graduation- Objective 1: During the 2026-2027 school year we will increase the graduation rate by 3%.
