•PeeWee Outdoor Soccer for Ages 3 thru 6

•Coed Friday Night Hoops - NEW!

Looking for a fun, competitive way to stay active this fall? Join our adult coed basketball league. Whether you are getting back into the game or play every week, this league is built for recreation and community, coed ages 25 - 99.

•Panther Junior Wrestling - Ages 5 - 12 as of 1/1/27

Wrestling is a fun and challenging sport which requires hard work and good attitude with sportsmanship and teamwork the focus. Wrestlers practice according to experience. Coaches will have final say for where wrestlers are placed. This is a great program for wrestlers to learn as well as compete in the growing sport of folk-style wrestling.

A mandatory parent orientation will be held October 5th at 6:00pm in the commons at Mountain View Middle School. Director *Melissa Olsen*, will provide an overview of the program and expectations.

Practices will be held two to three nights a week beginning October 6th, depending on gym availability. Tournaments are Saturdays or Sundays and are not included in registration fee.
