Course Description

While there is continued emphasis on proficiency, the Level IV-VI class, conducted in the language, pursues a more in-depth study of language, culture, and literature. Refinement of grammatical concepts and vocabulary enrichment are stressed. At the end of levels IV and V, students have the option to take the Advanced Placement Exam.
