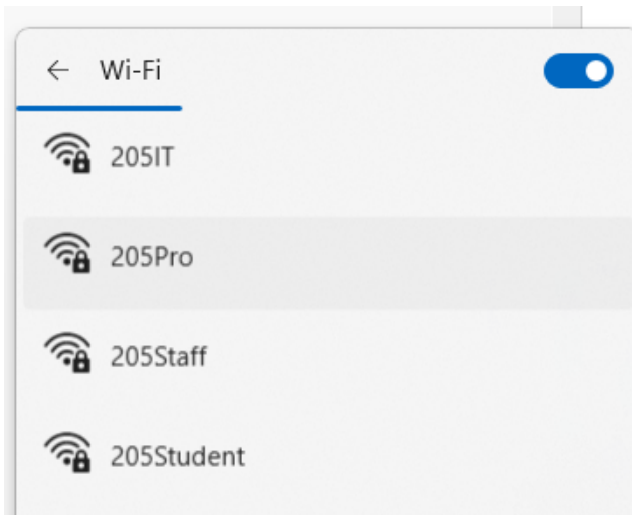


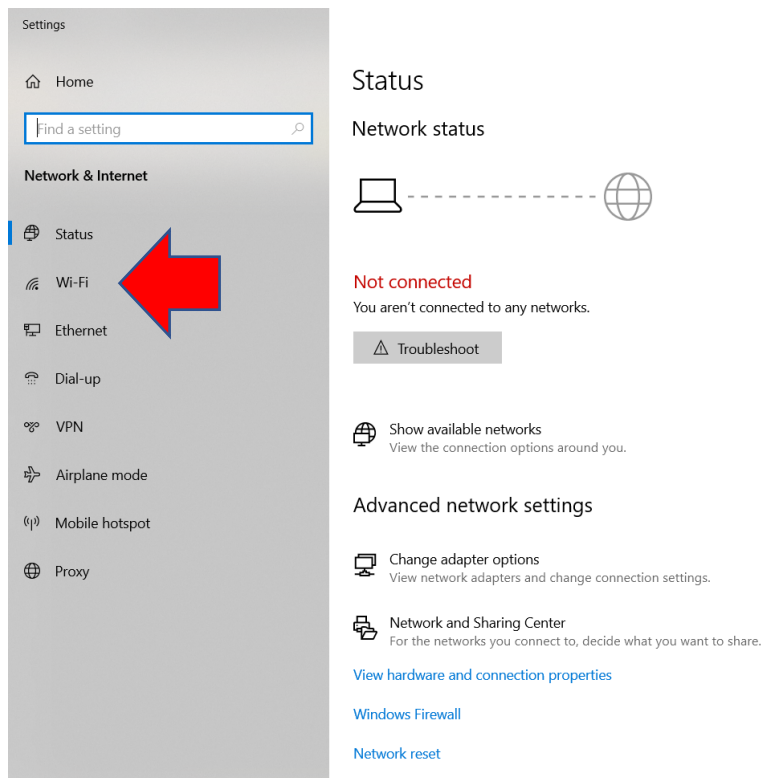
1. On the bottom right of your screen, click on the WIFI connection. Depending on if you are connected already or not, these are the two icons that you should look for. *(You may be connected to a hotspot or guest Wi-Fi.)*



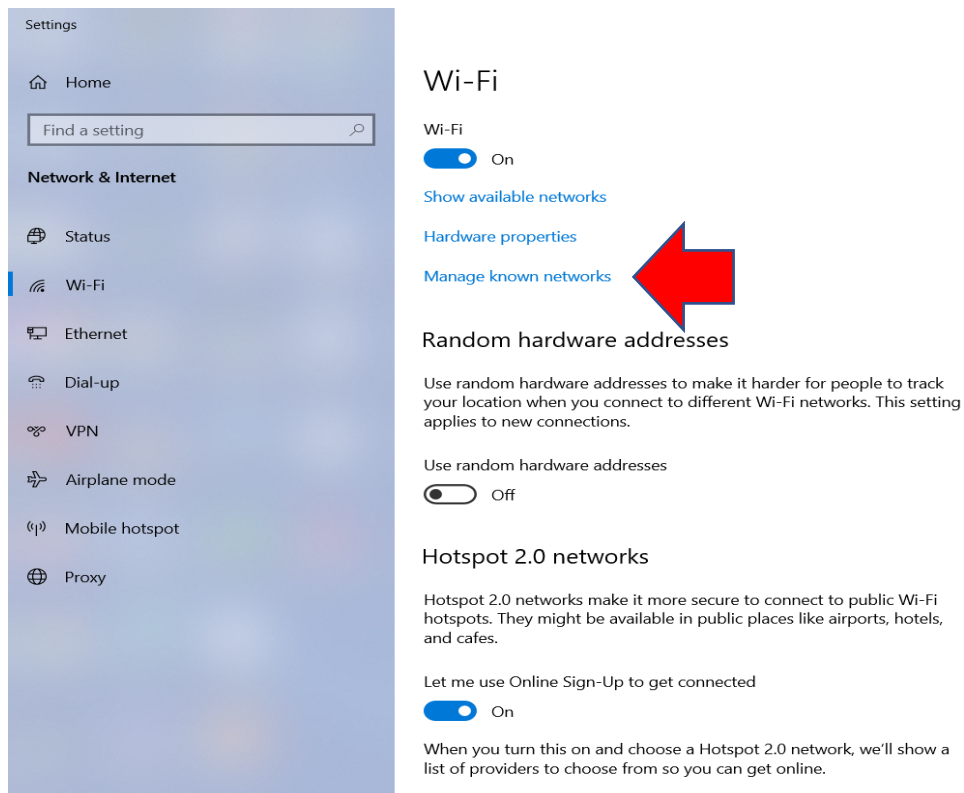
2. Next, click on Network & Internet Settings.



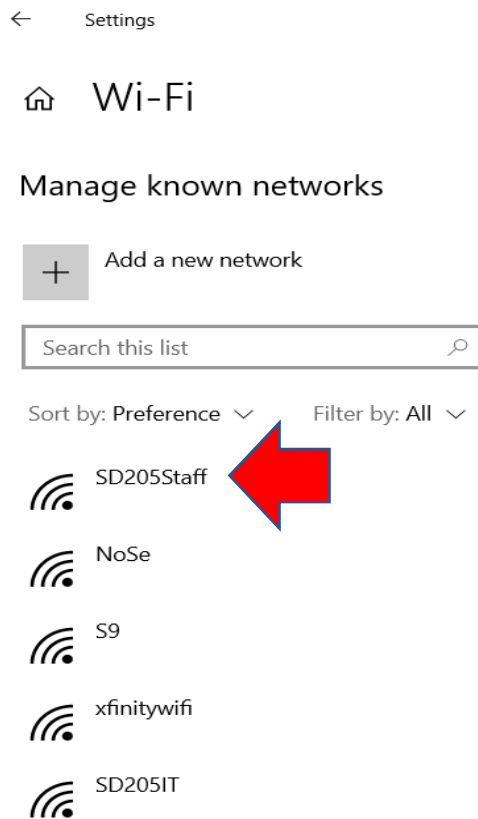
3. In this Settings window, click on Wi-Fi.



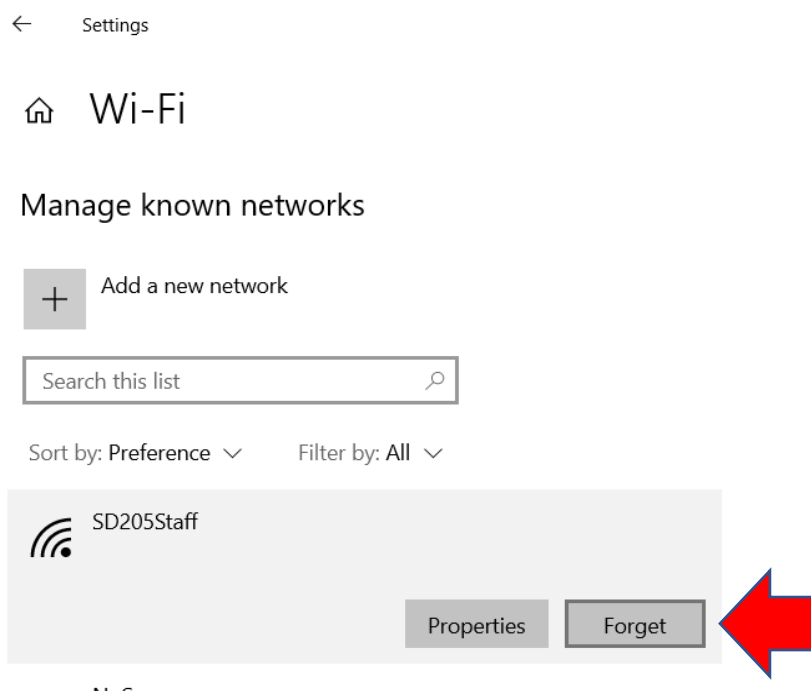
4. Then click on Manage known networks.



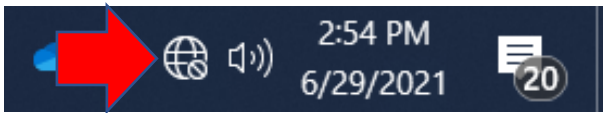
5. This next screen will show you all the WIFI connections the device has ever connected to. Find the one WIFI network you are trying to forget and click on it.



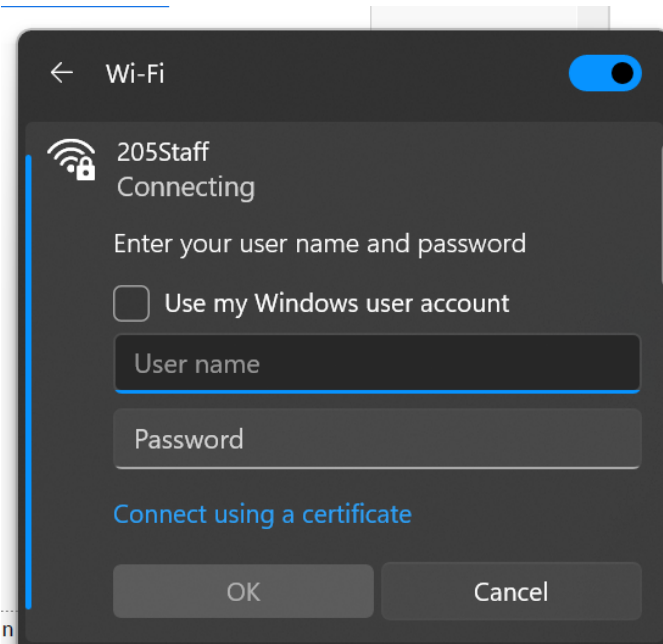
6. Now click on Forget.



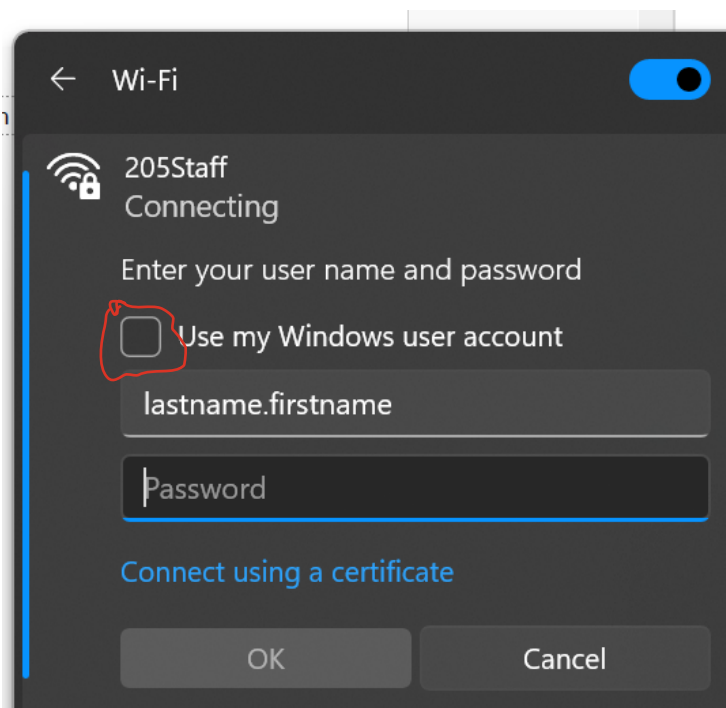
7. Now click on the wireless connection again at the bottom right.



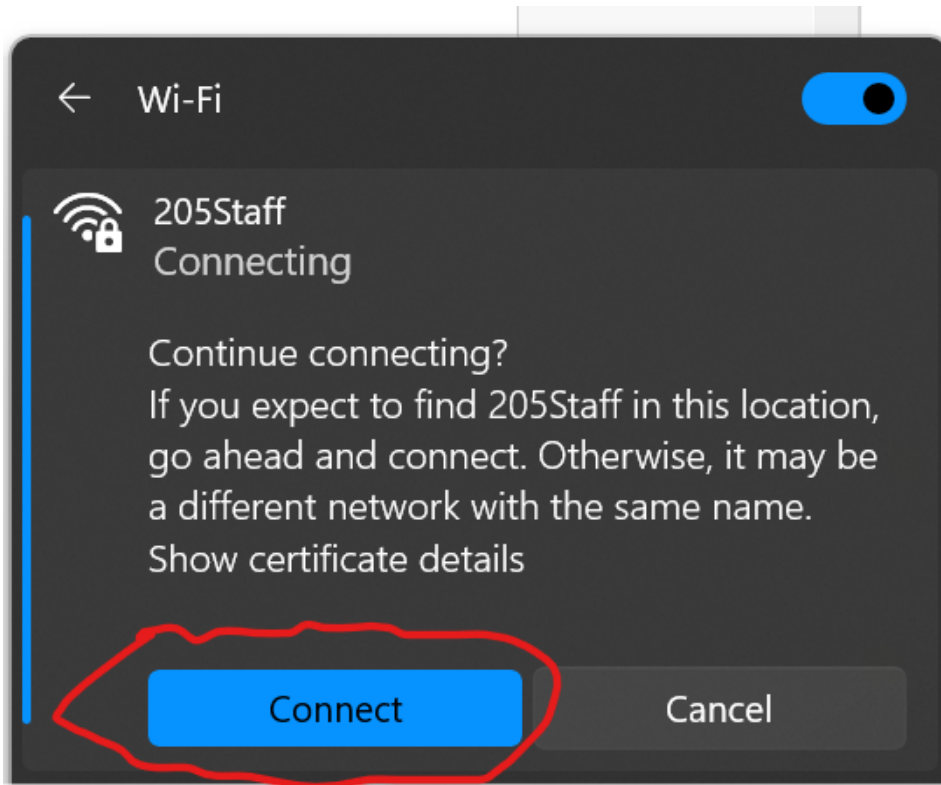
8. Click on 205Staff, and type in your user credentials. (Reminder that it's your PC credentials and **not your Google credentials.**)



9. If you're signing in with a district laptop, you can check the box and it will fill in the credentials for you.



10. Click connect and you should be good to go. If you are still having issues, email Helpdesk.



How to Connect to the New Wi-Fi

Important Note for All Users: The general connection process remains the same as previous methods, but please ensure you are using the specific login information outlined below. **Do not use your Google credentials.**

1. Staff Connection 205Staff

If you are a staff member, select the **205Staff** network from your device's Wi-Fi menu and enter the following:

- **Identity (Username):** Your standard login (Lastname.Firstname)
- **Password:** The same password you use to log into your desk computer.

2. Student Connection 205Student

If you are a student, select the **205Student** network from your device's Wi-Fi menu and enter the following exact formats:

- **Identity (Username):** The first 4 letters of your last name + the first letter of your first name + the last 4 digits of your ID number.
Example: If your name is John Smith and your ID is 1234567, your username is smitj4567.
- **Password:** Your initials + your full ID number.
Example: js1234567

💡 **Troubleshooting Tip for Students:** If your password doesn't work (this mainly affects New students, Sophomores, & Freshmen), make sure the **first letter** of your password is capitalized! (*Example: Js1234567*)

3. Chromebook Devices: Required Settings

If you or your students are using a Chromebook, please ensure the network settings match the exact criteria below when connecting to either **205Staff** or **205Student** for the first time.

(*Note: Once these settings are selected, scroll down slightly in that same window to enter the login info from Step 1 or Step 2).*)

- **Security:** EAP
- **EAP method:** PEAP
- **EAP Phase 2 authentication:** MSCHAPv2
- **Server CA certificate:** Do not check
