Rochester City School District Supplemental Tutoring Program

- Supplemental Tutoring Service:
 - Mechanism to make up for missed instruction due to chronic illness resulting in sporadic absenteeism often contributing to school failure
 - Service will provide 2 hours of tutoring per week in the home setting for the duration of the school year (from date of approval through June)
 - This is NOT Home Hospital Instruction for acute illness
- Eligibility Criteria:
 - Students attending the Rochester City School District in Grades K – 12 (this does not include parochial or Charter schools)
 - Diagnosis of a chronic medical condition
 - Absences from school totaling at least 15 – 20 days per school year associated with the stated illness &/or medical appointments
- Referral Process:
 - Students are referred for Supplemental Tutoring either through the health care provider, student health services at their home school or through the Office of Student Attendance at the Rochester City School District
 - The attached referral form can be used by the health care provider
 - The Office of Home Hospital / Tutoring receives the referral and is in contact with the school to determine if the student qualifies for the services
- Renewal Process:
 - Supplemental Tutoring needs to be renewed annually and will require documentation of continued illness / need for service from the health care provider
 - Parents of students currently in the program will be notified by the school (likely in May or June) for renewal information for the following school year. The parent is responsible for contacting the health care provider to obtain this information.
