Systems for Grades 6-12 Families



Schoology (Parent Account)

Schoology is used by the Secondary Building and teachers/staff to track students grades and assignments. Once students in grades 6-12 are active in Infinite Campus they will automatically have an account created. Families will also have their own Schoology account to track their secondary student's school work.



Access Your Schoology Account

This process works best on a computer- you will not be able to reset your password or set up your account on the app.

1. Go to <https://app.schoology.com>
2. Click "Forgot your password"
3. Type in your email address- the one on file in your Campus Parent Portal account
4. Instructions will be sent to your email address
"Note Schoology requires a 12-character long password"

When you sign into Schoology through the website on a computer, you may need to enter a School Name: South St. Paul Public Schools.



StudentSquare for Grades 6-12

SSPPS uses StudentSquare, for grades 6-12, as an add-on to our ParentSquare communications system. StudentSquare connects our staff with students in real time without the need to exchange personal information. Students can receive more information from their Connections teacher or coach.



StudentSquare highlights include:

- Hidden personal information for both staff and students for a safe and secure communication and workflow center
- Recorded/Archived posts, messages, and alerts for future reference
- Two-way communication allows messaging in real time
- Students can download the app for easier access and to choose how they receive notifications

SSPPS uses for StudentSquare:

- Teachers may send reminders to students about classroom items- tests, homework, or resources
- Coaches and advisors use it to communicate with their teams or groups
- Students can stay connected with information from the school
- Students can receive non-school day reminders and emergency closing notifications

How to Buy Game Tickets

Home game e-tickets can be purchased on Bound Ticketing. On the homepage look for “Tickets” on the top menu.

- SSP uses paperless ticketing and only electronic tickets (e-tickets) are accepted at the gate for events requiring paid admission
- Be prepared to show your mobile e-ticket to the gate attendant

How to Register for Activities

From the homepage, click on Registration on the top menu. If you have not yet created an account, click on “Create Account” in the upper left corner.

- Select “Family Dashboard,” and click on “Register”
- Complete the form for the activity for which you are registering and link your child by School ID number
- If you click Submit and cannot proceed due to your child’s outdated physical, you can submit a current physical in the documents of your student’s profile
