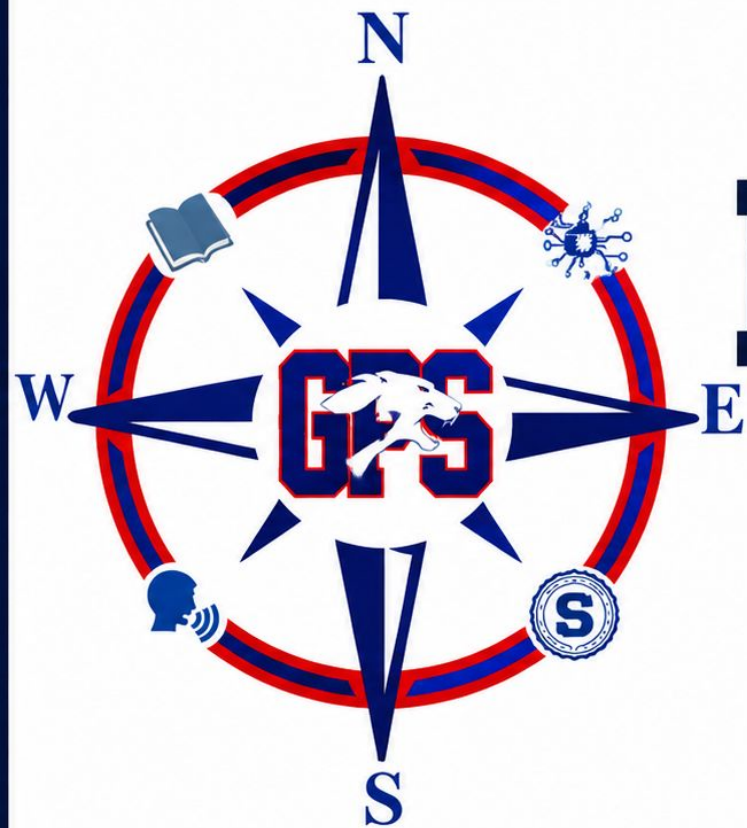

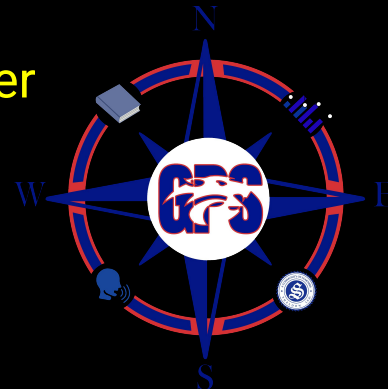

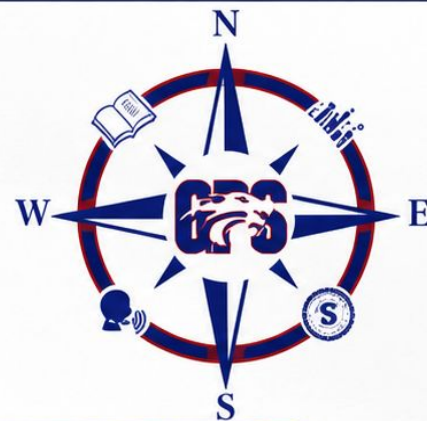

PERSONAL COMMUNICATION DEVICE POLICY

Students observed directly or indirectly (including by video) using a personal communication device during these hours will have the device confiscated.

1ST OFFENSE —

Confiscation; student retrieval.

2ND OFFENSE —

Confiscation; parent/guardian pickup.

3

3RD OFFENSE —

Confiscation; detention must be served;
THEN parent/guardian pickup.

4

4TH OFFENSE —

Confiscation; ISS;
THEN parent/guardian pickup.

5

5TH OFFENSE —

Confiscation pending a DAEP placement.



PICKUP RULE:

Friends, siblings, and other relatives may **NOT** retrieve a device.

When parent/guardian pickup is required, only a parent or guardian may retrieve it.



REFUSAL TO SURRENDER A DEVICE

ISS for insubordination.



RECORDING

Students using a cellphone to create social-media videos or record student misconduct may receive 2 days of ISS.

SO YOU WANT TO BE VALEDICTORIAN?



- 1 Math, Science, English, Social Studies, and LOTE classes count towards your GPA.
- 2 AP and Dual Credit classes in these areas provide 6 GPA points.
- 3 Pre-AP classes provide 5 GPA points.
- 4 Regular classes provide 4 GPA points.
- 5 You may not earn a grade higher than 95 in a dual credit course.
- 6 You should know your GPA and be able to calculate it at all times.

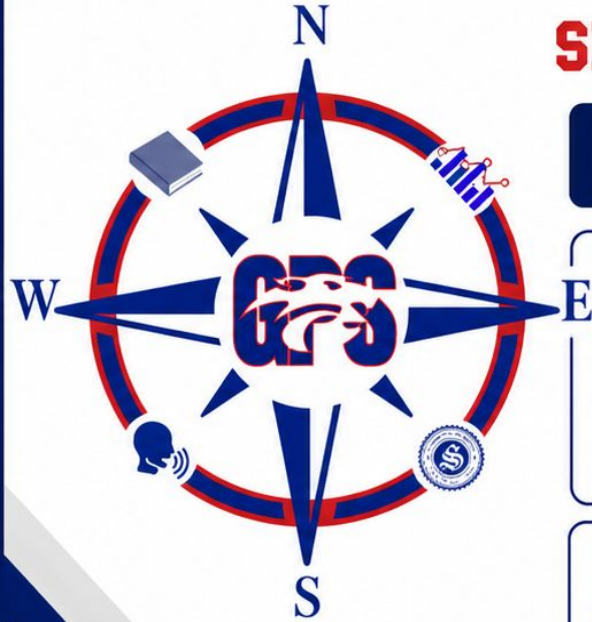

As you prepare for the **2026-2027** school year, be mindful of the following dress code standards:



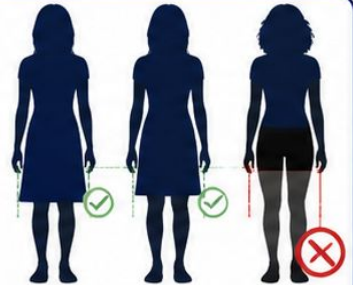
STUDENTS ARE ONLY ALLOWED TO WEAR NATURAL HAIR COLORS.
