How Much Are Graduation Tickets?

- Tickets go on sale in the student store from March 1st to April 2nd for \$5 with ASB and \$8 without; each graduate can purchase 5 tickets.
- Every senior will receive 2 free tickets at graduation practice.
- April 5th, remaining tickets will go on sale to the general public for \$8, three per person, while supplies last.
- VIP tickets are \$25 each, while supplies last (Field Seats), also go on sale March 1st.
- ALL GUESTS, including handicapped and babies, must have a ticket!

Is accessible seating available?

- Handicapped seating & parking are available in a restricted area with three guests/escort only.
- All must have a ticket, a handicapped placard, & your ID must match your placard.
- Handicapped seating and parking are available on a **limited** basis by reservation only.

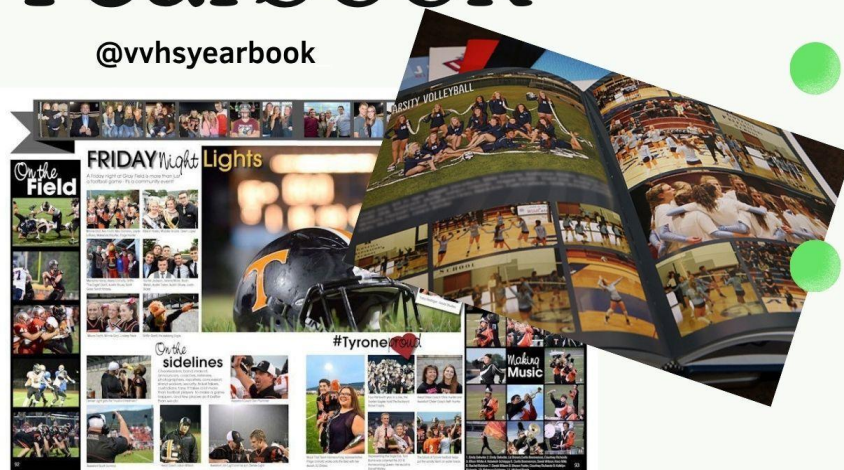

Victor Valley Union High School District Victor Valley High School Behavior Code for Senior Activities Notification Behavior Regulations for Senior Activities



Dear Senior Student:

This is to advise you of the Board of Education's policy regarding being under the influence of alcohol or a controlled substance and regarding the use, possession, furnishing, or sale of alcohol, any controlled substance, any look-alike substance, or involvement in any type of vandalism by any member of the senior class or his/her guest during senior activities, including while on, going to, or coming from school grounds or school activities. You are reminded that you are responsible and accountable for any infractions of the District Behavior code, Education Code Section 48900 A-R; Education Code Section (T); Education Code Section 48900.2, 48900.3, 48900.4, 48900.7, 48915(a); and/or 48915 (c). Restitution for damages resulting from any violation will be required.

Policy 5144 – Behavior Code for Senior Activities

It is the intent for the Board that students be aware of district policy regarding behavior by any member (or guest) of the senior class. Restitution for damages caused by any type of vandalism will be required. During the second semester of a school year any senior student who commits or participates in the commission of any act enumerated in the District Behavior Code. Education Code 233, 48900, 48900.2, 48900.3, 48900.4, 48900.7, 48915(a) and/ or 48915(c) while going to or coming from school, or a school-sponsored activity, or during the lunch period, whichever on or off campus, shall be subject to the following consequences:

*1. Exclusion from the activity and turned over to the appropriate authority, 2. Suspension or expulsion from, school, and 3. Exclusion from future activities. A. First Violation: Exclusion from school activities, with the exception of the graduation ceremony, for the remainder of the school year. These activities include but are not limited to: (1) junior/senior prom. (2) Senior field trip. (3) Senior week, and (4) baccalaureate. B. Second violation: Exclusion from the graduation ceremony. Any violation occurring during senior week will result in the removal of the student from the graduation ceremony. Any violation occurring during senior week will result in the removal of the student from the graduation ceremony and the remaining senior activities that week. An attempt shall be made by the principal or designee to notify the parent(s)/guardian(s) of such violations immediately. Appropriate disciplinary action shall be taken on the school day immediately following the activity if the incident occurred during non-school hours. Any senior student's guest who commits or participates in the commission of an act enumerated in the District Behavior Code, Education Code 233, 48900, 48900.2, 48900.3, 48900.4, 48900.7, 48915(a) and/or 48915(c) while attending school activity will be removed from the activity and turned over to parents/guardians and / or the police. All senior students and their parent(s)/guardian(s) shall be required to sign the "Notification of Behavior Regulations for Senior Activities." In the event the student and the parent(s)/guardian(s) of the student refuse to sign the "Notification of Behavior Regulations for Senior Activities" from within 10 days of the beginning of the second semester, the student will be excluded from all senior activities until such time as the document is signed.

Student/Parent or Guardian:

I have read and understand the above policy, including the rules and consequences related to the District Behavior Code and the use, possession, furnishing, or sale of alcohol, controlled substances, look-alike substances, drug paraphernalia, and any involvement in vandalism. I agree to follow all rules and regulations during senior activities. By signing this permission slip, students and parents/guardians acknowledge that appropriate behavior is expected at all times during the field trip. Any student who engages in inappropriate, unsafe, or disruptive behavior may be reported to the school administration by the chaperone. As a result, the student may lose the privilege of participating in future field trips for up to 12 months and/or may be subject to further disciplinary action.

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In the event the student and the parent(s) or guardians of the student refuse to sign the "Notification of Behavior Regulations for Senior Activities" form within ten (10) school days of the beginning of the semester, the student will be excluded from all senior activities until such time as the document is signed.
