Early Head Start/Head Start and child care funding is combined to create the full day. There is a cost associated with child care. We recommend that all families apply for child care assistance through Knox County Department of Job & Family Services.

Your Child May Be Eligible If Your Family Is:

- Preschool: At or below 130% of Federal Poverty Level (Based on 2025 income-proof of income required)
- Early Head Start/Head Start Child Care: At or below 100% of Federal Poverty Level (Based on 2025 income-proof of income required)
