NOTICE OF INTENDED ACTION***

POLICY NUMBER: 307

POLICY TITLE: Student Progression Plan

PURPOSE AND EFFECT: State law mandates the school district to maintain a written student progression plan. The plan serves as the district's official guide to how students progress from grade to grade, earn credits, graduate, and receive academic support, and it functions as both a resource for families and staff and a commitment to what students must accomplish and how the district will support their success.

SUMMARY OF THE ECONOMIC IMPACT ON THIS POLICY: There is no economic impact on any agency or individual other than the cost of promulgating and disseminating this policy.

CONSIDERATION BY THE SCHOOL BOARD OF VOLUSIA COUNTY: The proposed action will be considered by the School Board of Volusia County at the meeting to be held by the School Board on October 13, 2026, at the DeLand Administrative Complex, 200 North Clara Avenue, DeLand, Florida. The School Board shall set aside time for the purpose of receiving comment on the proposed action on or about 5:30 p.m. Speakers will be given up to three minutes to provide comment, in accordance with Volusia County School Board Policy 801. If any affected person under section 120.54, Florida Statutes, would like to request a hearing to present evidence and argument on any issue under consideration in the revision of the policy, he/she must submit such request in writing to the Agency Clerk, Ms. Celeste Gilmore, at 200 North Clara Avenue, DeLand, Florida, 32720. The request must be received by the Agency Clerk no later than 5 p.m., October 12, 2026.
