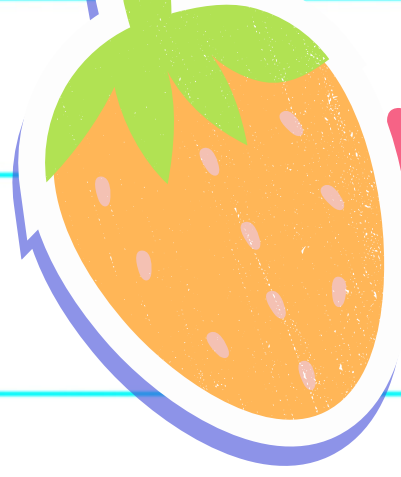
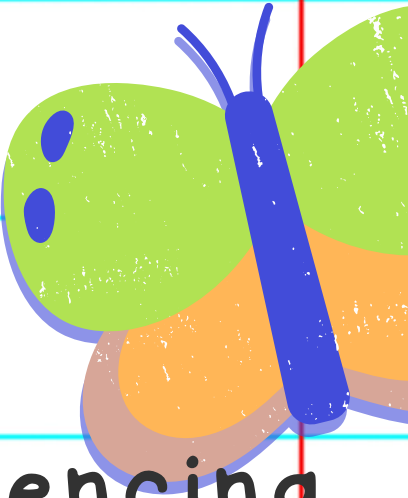




# What is a Title I School?



- Title I was passed in 1965 under the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA). It is the largest federal assistance program for our nation's schools.
- Title I schools receive extra funding from the federal government. These dollars are used to:



1. identify students experiencing academic difficulties and provide assistance to help these students;



2. purchase additional staff, programs, materials, and/or supplies; and



3. conduct parent and family engagement meetings, trainings, events, and/or activities.
