Position Summary:	Lewiston-Porter is seeking a part-time cafeteria monitor, with employment to begin with the 2026-2027 school year. Position is ten-months per year (September-June), 12.5 hours per week: Monday-Friday, 11:00am – 1:30pm. The primary purpose of this position is to support and monitor students in the cafeteria during dedicated meal times. The cafeteria monitor is responsible for assisting students in the school cafeteria as well as for monitoring the activities of students during their lunch period. Responsibilities also include wiping cafeteria tables between lunch periods; and cleaning up any messes that occur during the lunch period. Work is of a routine nature and is performed under the direct supervision of building administration. Does related work as required. Monitor may also have opportunity to apply for additional hours as a transportation monitor, monitoring and supporting the behavior of students while being transportation.
