On behalf of the Rialto Unified School District, we extend our heartfelt gratitude for the time, care, and dedication you so generously give to our students and school communities. Your presence on our campuses makes a meaningful difference each day. Volunteers are an essential part of our educational community—supporting student learning, fostering positive relationships, and strengthening connections between our schools and families. Please know that you are truly valued, and we sincerely appreciate all that you do.

We are writing to share an important update regarding a new California state requirement that will apply to all school district volunteers **beginning in the 2026–2027 school year.**

What's New

Under California law, Senate Bill 848 (SB 848), all school district volunteers who interact with students must complete annual Mandated Reporter Training. This training ensures that everyone supporting our schools has the knowledge needed to help keep students safe and supported.

How Do I Volunteer

Training must be completed before volunteering in any capacity.

- Obtain a volunteer form signed by the site principal
- Complete Mandated Reporter Training (link below)
 - New Volunteers - Schedule an appointment with HR for fingerprinting, after completion of TB test - Bring volunteer form, TB test results and Mandated Reporter Training Certificate
 - Continuing Volunteers - Schedule an appointment with HR - Bring the volunteer form and the Mandated Reporter Training Certificate to HR

To Access the Training:

This training is mandatory and must be completed in order to continue volunteering for the new school year. Volunteers may complete the training at home, at a convenient time, or at your child's school site upon request. The training will be available in English, Spanish, and many additional languages

Below is the link needed for the Mandated Reporter Training. Volunteers will need to create an account, which will include:

- 1) Create a Username (suggested 6 characters in combination of letters and numbers.
- 2) First and Last Name
- 3) Email Address

Once the account is created, the training will be visible.
