Critical Infrastructure

- Replace elevator
- Replace boilers
- Replace emergency generator
- Replace cooling tower
- Replace lighting controls
- Upgrade HVAC air distribution devices
- Replace select exterior windows not done in 2019 bond
- Upgrade lighting to LED
- Reinsulate chilled water piping



Safety & Security

- Add impact film at secondary exterior entrances
- Upgrades: lockdown, badge readers, intercom, cameras



Architecture

- Replace all carpet
- Provide new auditorium
- Provide band storage building near site athletics
- Add safety gates to exterior roll-up doors



Athletics

- Provide irrigation system booster pump
- Adjust baseball home plate pony wall and netting
- Provide new football bleachers to code and current capacity standards
- Improve field event landing material
- Replace boys' athletic lockers
- Install competition and auxiliary gym basketball shot clocks
- Replace irrigation at practice fields
- Replace baseball and softball batting cage netting
- Replace football scoreboards with CFISD standard
- Resurface tennis courts and replace windscreen
- Replace track & field event throw netting
- Respray track top layer and restripe
- Replace baseball turf
- Replace softball turf
