WHAT IS PROPOSED FOR CYPRESS SPRINGS?



Critical Infrastructure

- Make Commons/Cafeteria one level
- Replace electrical switchgear
- Replace emergency generator
- Replace intercom system
- Replace lighting controls
- Upgrade lighting to LED
- Recover roof (except for 2014 and 2019 Bond scope)



Safety & Security

- Add impact film at secondary exterior entrances
- Upgrades: lockdown, badge readers, intercom, cameras



Architecture

- Add safety gates to exterior roll-up doors
- Provide band storage building near site athletics



Athletics

- Improve field event landing material
- Provide new full-pour track surface and restripe
- Install pool deck channel drains
- Install new pool sound system
- Replace football turf
- Replace scoreboards in all gyms
- Replace 6 tennis courts including seating, lighting, and windscreens
- Replace competition and auxiliary gym bleachers
- Install competition and auxiliary gym basketball shot clocks
- Replace baseball and softball batting cage netting
- Replace track & field event throw netting
- Replace pool plaster, steps, return fittings, ladders, chlorine system, deck, diving board, scoreboard, timing system, water line tile, main drain cover, and pool lane lines with spool carrier
- Replace football scoreboards with CFISD standard



Other Improvements

- Improve welding ventilation to industrial and agricultural technology

Infrastructure

- Portable building refresh
- Playground enhancement and equipment



Technology

- Update network infrastructure, cybersecurity, and classroom, student, teacher, and staff devices



Transportation

- New school buses
- Retrofit buses with emergency, safety or security equipment
- Police department vehicle upgrades
