What is California Education for a Global Economy - Ed.G.E. (Proposition 58)?

In November 2016, California voters approved Proposition 58, also known as the CA Ed.G.E. Initiative. The purpose of the CA Ed.G.E. Initiative is to ensure that all children in California public schools receive the highest quality education, master the English language, and access high-quality, innovative, and research-based language programs that prepare them to fully participate in a global economy. The CA Ed.G.E. Initiative authorizes school districts and county offices of education to establish language acquisition programs for both native and non-native English speakers, and requires school districts and county offices of education to solicit parent and community input in developing language acquisition programs.

If the available LBUSD Language Program is not an option at a school site, Proposition 58 outlines the following:

When parents or guardians of 30 or more students in a school make a request for a new program by November 15th...

OR

When parents or guardians of 20 or more students at a grade level in a school make a request by November 15th...

THEN...

- ◆ Within 10 days of receiving the number of requests noted above, the district provides written notification to parents and school personnel that a new program has been requested.
- ◆ The district conducts an analysis to determine if it can supply the materials, teaching faculty, and facilities necessary to run the program.
- ◆ Within 60 days of reaching the required amount of requests, the district provides notice of its feasibility determination.
- ◆ The district provides the requested program **if possible** for the following school year.
