

DUAL CREDIT ENROLLMENT

Anna ISD students have the opportunity to earn **both high school and college credit** through dual credit courses offered in partnership with **Collin College**. A variety of dual credit courses may be available based on student interest, academic needs, prerequisites, and college course offerings.

Dual credit courses are Level III weighted courses, and students should expect the course content, expectations, and workload to reflect a college-level course.

The general process to participate in dual credit courses includes:

1. **Counselor Consultation:** Meet with your counselor to discuss available Dual Credit courses and requirements.
2. **College Application:** Students must complete the college admissions application through ApplyTexas.

3. **Eligibility/Testing:** Student must meet the required college-readiness standards through the **TSI Assessment** and/or qualifying scores on the **STAAR, ACT, or SAT**, as applicable.

The TSI Assessment is offered once a month at our campus with a cost of \$15 or at one of the Collin Community College campuses for \$29.

4. **Registration:** Once students complete the required steps, your counselor and the Collin Community Counselor, Merissa Hall, will assist with registering for the appropriate Dual Credit courses.
5. **Tuition/Fees:** Any applicable tuition or fees will be paid through the college's student portal.

Students and parents are strongly encouraged to attend dual credit information sessions offered by Anna High School to learn about eligibility requirements, course options, deadlines, costs, and expectations.
