Ohio now offers statewide behavioral health crisis support for youth ages 20 and under.

How MRSS works

- **Call 988 and ask for MRSS.**
- **We come to you** — at home, school, or another safe place — usually within an hour or at a time that works best for you.
- **We'll continue to work with you up to 42 days** if needed.

What is MRSS?

- Mobile Response and Stabilization Services are for youth age 20 and under who are experiencing a behavioral health crisis or emotional distress.
- You define the crisis. If it feels like one, call 988 and ask for MRSS.
- This is a no-cost program. You do not need insurance. You will not get a bill.



What does a crisis look like?

You define the crisis, but it might involve:

	Feeling overwhelmed, very sad, or hopeless.
	Talking about self-harm or hurting someone else.
	Showing extreme anger or fear.
	Having a hard time coping at home, school, or with friends.
	Behaving in ways that seem unsafe or very out of character.
	If there is physical harm or the immediate threat of physical harm to the youth or any other person, call 911.
