RETURNING STUDENTS:

- Every year we must have all back-to-school forms completed for every student.
- Contact the FMS office at FMSoffice@freemansd.org if you need help logging into your Family Access Account.
- Please log in to Family Access and complete form sets for each student.
 - You can find this on the left side of your home page on the Skyward Family Access screen titled
 - “FMS Registration for All Returning Students”.
 - Included in the forms is our Chromebook Assurance Plan Opt-In/Opt-Out Form. For you to opt-in for this "insurance", you will need to select opt-in AND pay your \$20 premium no later than September 15th, 2026

- If you have not yet created an account for yourself and your student in Final Forms, please do so ASAP and select which sports they plan to participate in for the 2026-2027 school year. Parents must create a parent account and then an individual account for each student. There are forms for both parents and students to complete each year.
- Sports physicals are required to participate in practice the first day. They are valid for two years from the date of completion. (If you have a new physical, please bring it to the office and we will get it uploaded into Final Forms or you may scan it and upload it yourself. If you manually uploaded yours, we must go in and approve each one individually and will be working on that ASAP. SPORTS FEES/ASB CARDS:

- We ask that student-athletes pay for their ASB card and extracurricular participation fees before the first athletic competition.
- Middle School Sport Participation Fees - ASB Card (once annually) - \$30. Transportation Fee (once annually) -\$10 Yearly Total- \$40

You may notice new signage posted on windows/doors on our campus identifying the end of public access areas and the beginning of secured school property.
