### APPLICATION FOR MOTOR VEHICLE PRIVILEGES

1. Only completed applications will be considered (a copy of student's driver's license must be presented when receiving the parking tag, or license presented for copying).
2. Forgery of parent signature shall result in loss of student permit for the entire school year.
3. The student must submit evidence to the office that he/she and the vehicle which he/she will be driving are covered by property and bodily injury liability insurance sufficient to meet the financial responsibility laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
4. The student driver and his/her parent/guardian shall agree by their signatures on the application form to be financially responsible for any damage done to school property by his/her vehicle.
5. The following traffic regulations shall be carefully observed in addition to all normal traffic laws, requirements and rules as outlined in the Student Handbook:
  - All stop signs and other related traffic signs are to be observed.
  - There shall be no passing of moving vehicles on any roadway or driveway on school property.
  - The vehicle may not be used in any manner during the school day, except for initial arrival and departure, unless specific permission is granted.
  - The arrival and departure operations of the student vehicle shall at all times be in strict observance of all practices in keeping with student safety, on and off loading buses, as well as pedestrians and other motor vehicle operators.
  - In the interest of safety, vehicles are asked to exit directly from the parking lot to Fireline Road. Student vehicles are not permitted to exit via the front of the building during normal morning and afternoon arrival and departure.
  - Unwarranted stops or spinning of tires of any vehicle shall be construed as reckless driving.
  - Upon arrival at school, drivers are to lock their vehicle doors (for security reasons) and report to the building. There is to be no loitering in the school parking lot.
  - The parking permit **MUST** be displayed at all times.
  - The school district reserves the right to search any vehicle on school property.
  - The use of tobacco, drugs or alcohol will result in a suspension of the student's driving privilege.
  - Excessive tardiness, (10 tardies/year or 5 tardies/semester) will result in loss of parking privileges.
  - Students are to exit their parked vehicle and enter the cafeteria or wait out in front of the high school until the 7:20AM bell.
6. The issuance of a student's permit for motor vehicle privileges, when coupled with a PA driver's license, imposes upon the holder the responsibilities and obligations of an adult. Common sense and good judgment are most important in safe, sane vehicle operation.
7. If you are driving a different car, you must notify the high school office.
8. The student parking permit is a **PRIVILEGE**, not a right, and should be recognized as such. Violations may result in towing the car at the owner's expense and/or loss of the privilege.
9. Students will be required to pay a **non-refundable \$10.00 fee** for their parking permit and must show their driver's license to receive their parking pass.
