Kelly Liu	3. Public Comment - Agenda and Non-Agenda Items	Approve/ A favor	Written Comment/Comentario escrito	My name is Kelly Liu and I am a rising senior at Valley Christian High School. I am also co-founder and co-director of ConServe, a youth-led 501c3 nonprofit dedicated to advancing sustainability in K12 schools. Since ConServe's founding, we have passed climate action resolutions in over 20 school districts that house over 420,000 students. Most importantly, we've recently passed an Air Pollution Recognition Resolution within the Santa Clara County Office of Education that recognizes the threats that air pollution poses to our youth and commits the county to integrating air pollution literacy into curriculum. Building off of this momentum, we have been working with many others to model the resolution. We are hoping to work with the San Diego County Office of Education to pass a similar resolution that could either recognize air pollution as a threat to youth, integrate air pollution into curriculum, or work to combat and monitor air pollution in a tangible manner.
