

To all Turkey Foot Middle School Families, (8/14/26)

We are getting so excited about your children returning to school next week. We've been working hard to get things ready. We've given our staff great, intentional professional development, and we're a few days away from the first day of school. I wanted to send you all some information to help prepare.

Construction Project Update

I was informed by our Central Office that due to delays with certain aspects of the demolition project of the Patton building, that project has been pushed to Summer of 2027. When I get further updates, I will share those with you.

Parent Drop Off



When dropping off your child in front of the building, please pull forward in the line as much as possible. This will help us prevent cars backing up onto Turkeyfoot Road. We will be waving you forward, this really helps with the flow of traffic.

Parent Pick Up



Please Park in the parking lots outlined in red if you are planning to pick up your child after school. The lot on the right of this image is Lot A. The lot on the bottom left of this image is Lot D. There should be plenty of spaces available for you.

Change: The lot across from the Patton building is now marked as a **one way only**. Those lanes are now one way only. One entering and one exiting. This is intentional to help the flow of traffic for our campus. Please park in the designated spaces outlined in red above.

Start/End Time

Our doors open at 7:10 AM.

We start school at 8:00 AM daily. This means your student should be in their classroom ready to start class at 8:00 AM. Please plan accordingly to drop them off with enough time to get to class.

School ends everyday at 2:40 PM. We dismiss students in waves to help with traffic flow.

Dress Code

Dress Code

- Shorts, skirts, skorts and dresses must be appropriate wearing apparel for school sessions as long as they meet the dress code. A rule of thumb is that the student can stand straight with hands to side and fingertips not touching bare skin.
- Holes in pants and other garments will follow the same criteria as shorts. A rule of thumb is that the student can stand straight with hands to side and fingertips not touching bare skin.
- Neither the fabric, nor fit, nor fashion of the article of clothing shall allow exposure of undergarments, the midriff, or the bare back whether the student is seated, standing or moving.
- Narrow strapped tops, halters, crop, or tube tops are not permitted. A rule of thumb is that all should have at least a three finger width strap and covers the shoulder of the student.
- Pants must be worn at waist level. Pants must be appropriate size and may not drag on the floor.
- **Sweatshirts with hoods are permitted but hoods are not to be worn.**
- Hats and/or sunglasses or other items that may obscure a person's identity must be removed upon entering the building.
- Bandanas or other items that may represent gang colors or gang paraphernalia are prohibited.
- Jewelry intended for piercing may NOT create a safety concern or be disruptive to the educational process as determined by the Principal or their designee.
- Shoes must be worn at all times. Shoes must have solid soles that are attached with laces or straps (athletic shoes, slides, and flip flops are acceptable). **House shoes/ slippers are not permitted.**
- Any type of shoe skates are not permitted.
- Any clothing or accessories that may cause a distraction or interruption to the educational process or is a potential safety concern is subject to review by the school administration.
- Strictly prohibited are any types of clothing or accessories that promote alcohol, drugs, gangs, weapons, tobacco, violence, sexual behavior, profanity, discrimination, through word, pictures or innuendo. Any wording or graphics on any part of the clothing must not relate to drugs or alcohol, gangs and/or violence.

We also do not permit students to bring blankets to school.

Parents, we need your help! Please check your child's outfit before they leave the house. Sometimes a quick glance can save a headache from happening!

Schedule Requests

We have now completed schedule pickup. We have worked hard to ensure all students are scheduled. We are not accepting schedule change requests unless there are extreme extenuating circumstances. Please do not ask for a schedule change because your child is not scheduled with their friend(s).
