Our promise is to provide an innovative and personalized learning environment that ensures that every child achieves excellence.

Please review the following arrival and dismissal procedures to help ensure a safe and efficient start to the first day of school and throughout the 2026-2027 school year:

First Day of School – Arrival and Dismissal Procedures.

First Day of School: Thursday, September 10, 2026

Instructional Hours: 8:20 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.

K-8:

ARRIVAL:

This is a reminder that if you are driving your child to school, the area directly in front of the building is a **NO PARKING LANE**. Please observe the cones that are placed there for the school buses arriving. If you wish to escort your child to the door, you must, first, locate street parking and then walk your child to the building. We work hard to expedite vehicle traffic and the safe arrival and departure of our students.

Non-bus students who report to school between 7:50 a.m. and 8:20 a.m. will enter through one of two doors based upon their grade level. K-4 students will enter through the Education Center and while 5-8 students will enter through the Student Center. All students will report to the gym.

At 8:20 a.m., all students will walk to their homeroom where they will eat breakfast.

*For the first day of school **only**, Kindergarten students will report directly to their classroom. Parents may accompany them to the classroom for the first day **only**.

Any non-bus student who reports to school after 8:20 a.m. will enter through the Student Center and be considered tardy. These students will receive a late pass and then report to class. Any student who is tardy fifteen (15) times, will jeopardize their placement here at iPrep Academy.

DISMISSAL:

Bus students will be placed on their buses in front of the Student Center at 3:00 p.m. for dismissal.

Kindergarten students and Grades 2-5 non-bus students will be dismissed from the Education Center by their teacher in the playground on Magnolia Street. Parents **must** bring proof of ID on the first day of school so we can verify them.

Grade 1 students will be dismissed in front of the building on Court Street.

Grades 6-8 students who walk home will have the option of leaving either via Court Street or Magnolia Ave.

*** Please let your child's teacher know, in writing, who will pick up the child after school or if the child will walk home.**

NOTE: Students who are NOT picked up on time from their designated areas will be taken to the iLeap center where they will have to be signed out by a parent/legal guardian with a proper form of identification. If there is a trend or pattern of a student being picked up late, it will be reported to the district and appropriate authorities.

[Immunization Requirements](#)



Kindergarten - Please be advised that the State of New Jersey, Department of Health Services, has changed several immunization requirements. All children attending licensed childcare centers and preschools are required to receive an annual flu vaccination. Please submit proof of your child's required immunization as soon as possible, but ***no later than November 30, 2026***. Students who do not have the required immunization documentation on file by November 30, 2026, ***will be excluded from school beginning December 1, 2026***, in accordance with New Jersey immunization regulations.

Grade 7 - The state of New Jersey Department of Health ***requires*** all students entering the seventh grade to have **one dose of Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria, and Pertussis vaccine) and one dose of Meningococcal vaccine.** To meet the New Jersey requirements, both vaccines must have been given **on or after your child's tenth birthday.** Documentation that your child has received the required seventh grade immunizations must be turned into the school nurse no later than ***Thursday, September 10th, 2026.***

Students entering 7th grade with birthdays on or after ***Thursday, September 10th, 2026,*** must provide written confirmation from your child's healthcare provider of the vaccination appointment. This appointment should be within two weeks of your child turning 10 years of age. The immunization record must be submitted immediately following the appointment. The Elizabeth Public School District is compelled by law to ensure that all students receive their required immunizations.

Please be advised that students who do not meet the State's immunization requirements may be excluded from school until the required documentation is submitted. Documentation must be signed by your child's healthcare provider.

[Updated Cell Phone Policy](#)

Elizabeth Public Schools has adopted an updated cell phone policy in accordance with New Jersey Department of Education Guidelines and state law that, at minimum, requires schools to prohibit the use of personal

internet-enabled devices during the entirety of the school day for students in kindergarten through grade 12. The policy will be implemented as follows:

K-5: Policy: Students are not permitted to bring cell phones or devices to school. If brought to school: Cell phones and devices must be checked in the classroom upon arrival and stored securely for the duration of the school day. They will be returned to students at the end of the day. Parents will receive a notification via Class Dojo or School Messenger (PowerSchool) from the school requesting that personal devices be left at home.

Grades 6-8: Policy: Students are not permitted access to their cell phones or other devices at school during school hours. Students are encouraged to leave devices at home. If brought to school: Cell phones and devices must be checked in the classroom upon arrival and stored securely for the duration of the school day. Students will re-gain access to their device at the end of each school day.
