An important part of our program at Cooke is community-based instruction. CBI provides students the opportunity to learn and practice vocational and life skills in the actual settings in which they'll be expected to apply them. CBI includes pre-teaching and follow-up activities, so that skills are introduced, taught and practiced, and then reviewed.

Students are transported in Northville Public School buses. In order to simplify the paperwork involved, we request that you authorize permission for your student to be transported for community-based instructional activities. We will not send home permission slips for specific trips throughout the school year.

I understand that my child(ren) will be transported by a school bus/rented bus and will be supervised at all times and that the Northville Public Schools cannot be held responsible for any accidents that may occur. I also understand the No Fault Insurance Law as it applies to students who are passengers in school district vehicles. In consideration of my child(ren) participating in and attending the activity, I agree, on my behalf and on behalf of my child(ren), to the following:

a. To discharge and release the Northville Public Schools, its Board of Education, employees, agents, representatives and the activity chaperones from all claims, demands, damages, suits, actions, causes of action and all liability whatsoever, in law or in equity, which may accrue or arise during, out of or be related to my child(ren) attending the activity, including, but not limited to, all liabilities and/or claims resulting from the negligence of the released parties for all injuries to my child(ren), and all liabilities and/or claims for injuries to my child(ren) arising out of, or related to, transportation to and from the activity.

b. To indemnify and save harmless same from and against all claims, demands, actions, causes of action, suits, and damages, including, but not limited to, all damages, court costs and attorney fees as a result of any injury or damages to persons or property resulting from any acts or omissions of my child(ren).

**No Fault Insurance Law
Students Who Are Passengers In School District Vehicles**

Personal Injury Protection is provided by the student's family automobile insurance. The District's insurance carrier would only assume responsibility for personal injury if there were no insured automobiles in the student's family. The District would be liable for serious injury if the driver of the district's vehicle was at fault for the accident.

Note: Participation in CBI trips is encouraged, however student participation remains voluntary.
