



Board Guardrails

1. The Board will not direct operational responsibility to anyone except the Superintendent or engage in any action that impedes upon the day-to-day operations, administrative or otherwise, of the district.
2. The Board will not try to influence or intimidate the Student Board Member into making a response or taking a position whether at a board meeting or at any other time.
3. The Board may not make decisions, policies, or changes to policies that lack clear alignment with the District's and Board's established strategic goals, policies, values, or guardrails without input from the greater Long Beach community.
