<u>Tops:</u>	Grade-level color polo shirts, short or long-sleeved optional GMS logo ○ 6th Grade- Heather gray polos (NOT LIGHT OR DARK) ○ 7th Grade- Gold polos (NOT YELLOW) ○ 8th Grade- Black polos T-shirts are not permitted on uniform days. Students must wear a collared polo shirt. Shirts must be tucked into their pants at all times while on campus. If a shirt is untucked, it is considered a violation of the student code of conduct, and a consequence will be assigned. Please purchase a black belt for your student.	
<u>Bottoms</u>	● Black uniform slacks, capris, shorts or skirts (knee length). ● NO DENIM black jeans. ● Scholars are NOT allowed to wear cargo pants. ● No leggings, spandex, or tight clothing (No Pointe tight-fitting material). Uniform pants must fit appropriately. ● No sagging pants (DISD policy). Belts Required.	
<u>Shoes:</u>	● No open-toe shoes or open heels. ● No sandals, Crocs, or house slippers. ● All black shoes are preferred, or with the school colors.	
<u>Cardigans & Jackets:</u>	● All-black or all-gray cardigans and jackets are preferred. ● Logos must not contain offensive slogans, symbols, or other suggestive or controversial designs. Parents, please check your scholar's attire before they walk out the door. ● <u>Sweater vests</u> are allowed. Black or gray are preferred.	
<u>Backpacks, Bags & Purses:</u>	● <u>Clear plastic backpack.</u> ● NO Mesh backpacks. ● All athletic bags and pencil bags must be clear. ● Purses must be clear and not be more than 10 inches long and 6 inches tall. ● Scholars may have One zippered pouch that is not clear for personal items 5.5"x 8.5" or smaller. Additional bags will be confiscated. ● Lunch bags are allowed and they do not have to be clear.	
<u>ID Badges:</u>	● All scholars will be issued 1 ID badge at the start of the year free of charge. Parents, check your scholar's attire to ensure they have the lanyard around their neck and are set for success. ● ID badges must be worn on a lanyard and must be visible at all times around the neck. ● Lanyards on the back pocket are NOT allowed. ● Parents are responsible for buying a lanyard and the plastic ID holder to protect the ID.	

- The badge cannot have stickers, drawings, be broken or tampered. Parents, please buy a lanyard.
- **If an ID badge is lost, a replacement fee will be charged in accordance with the campus policy.**

Other:

Confiscated items will only be returned to parents.

Prohibited and Restricted Items

Food, Drinks, and Deliveries

- Only clear water bottles are allowed.
- Reusable water bottles must be empty before entry.
- Disposable water bottles must be unopened.
- No other drinks of any kind, including coffee, energy drinks, sodas, or flavored beverages.
- Snacks must be individually-sized, snack-size, or fun-size and remain sealed.
- Only 1 snack type of each. For example, only 1 bag of chips, 1 bag of cookies, 1 bag of crackers, 1 granola bar.
- Open snacks will be confiscated.
- No sharing food with other scholars.
- Family-size bags of chips or large snack containers are not permitted and will be confiscated.
- Healthy snacks only are strongly recommended.
- No candy or gum.
- No outside food deliveries (Uber Eats, DoorDash, Grubhub, etc.).
- Scholars must bring their lunch with them upon arrival to school.

Personal Items and Accessories

- No blankets or stuffed animals.
- No stuffed-animal backpacks or bags.
- No balloons or gift bags.
- No excessive amounts of cash. Bringing more than \$10 is discouraged.
- No playing cards, dice, gambling items, or other items that may disrupt learning.
- No athletic balls.
- No permanent markers, permanent pens, or Sharpies.
- No laser pointers.
- No selling, purchasing, trading, raffling, or distributing items without administrative approval.

Technology and Electronic Devices

- AirPods and similar wireless earbuds are not allowed.
- Cell phones must be turned off, and scholars must follow campus procedures for collection and storage. **If a scholar does not comply with campus expectations, the parent will be required to pick up the cell phone, and a monetary fee will be assessed in accordance with district policy.**
- Smart watches must not cause distractions or interfere with learning.
- No Meta Smart Glasses or similar wearable recording devices.
- No filming, photographing, livestreaming, or recording others without permission.
- No posting or sharing images, videos, or content of others without permission.
- No creation or sharing of social media content that disrupts the school environment.

Health, Hygiene, and Personal Care

- Hygiene products must be travel size only.
- No aerosol sprays of any kind, including deodorant. Bar only.
- No makeup or beauty products of any kind.
- No glass containers, including perfume, cologne, or beverage containers.
- No medication may be carried by a scholar. All medications must be provided directly to the nurse by a parent/guardian and accompanied by required documentation.

- If a scholar becomes ill during the school day, they must report to the nurse's office. The school nurse is the designated person responsible for assessing the scholar's condition, contacting parents or guardians when necessary, and authorizing a scholar to be sent home for health-related reasons.

Appearance Expectations

- Nails must not create safety concerns or cause disruptions to the learning environment.
- Hair color should resemble natural hair colors.

Safety and Security

- No weapons of any kind. This includes but is not limited to toy weapons, look-alike weapons, and replica weapons.
- No pocket knives or items that resemble weapons.
- No toy guns, water guns, Nerf guns, toy knives, or similar items.
- No chains, spikes, or accessories that could pose a safety concern.
- No pepper spray, mace, tasers, stun guns, or self-defense devices of any kind.
- No vapes, e-cigarettes, alcohol, tobacco products, controlled substances, or other prohibited substances.
- Possession of vapes, alcohol, drugs, or other prohibited substances may result in an automatic DAEP placement in accordance with district policy.

Campus Expectations

- Scholars are expected to bring only items necessary for learning.
- Any item that causes a disruption, creates a safety concern, interferes with instruction, or violates district policy may be confiscated and may result in disciplinary consequences.
- Office drop-offs are only accepted from parents between 8:30 a.m. and 10:00 a.m.
- If an item is confiscated, it can be picked up by the parents from the office from 4:00-4:30 pm.

Administration has the right to prohibit any item not specifically listed above if it is determined to be unsafe, disruptive, inappropriate for the school setting, or in violation of Dallas ISD policies and procedures.

If scholars are not wearing the appropriate uniform, parents will be called and asked to bring the appropriate uniform. If the appropriate uniform is not provided, the scholar will be placed in the reset center due to the Level I Offence Dress Code Violation.
