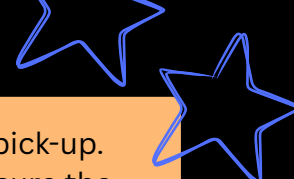

GAP Site Information

- **Bring your phone:** Please have your cell phone with you for drop-off and pick-up. You'll need to call the site to be let in, as this is our security protocol to ensure the safety of all children and staff.
 - **Afternoon pick-up:** The person picking up your child in the afternoon must have their photo ID ready. If a person other than a parent or guardian is picking up, their name must be listed on your child's registration form.
 - **Absences:** If your child won't be at the GAP site on a particular afternoon, please call the site to let them know.
 - **Changes to your account:** Any changes to your child's usage, including extra days or withdrawals, must be communicated directly with the Site Coordinator. They will provide a form for you to fill out.
 - **Stay informed:** Each GAP site publishes a monthly newsletter with information about upcoming activities and events. Be sure to check it out!

- **Location:** The Friday GAP program is held at Mullan Trail Elementary School, located at 12th and Compton, by the back playground.
 - **What to Bring:** Please make sure your child comes prepared with a morning snack, a packed lunch (we cannot heat up food), a water bottle, a backpack to hold any artwork, and clothing appropriate for the weather.
 - **Adding a Friday:** If you need to add Fridays to your child's schedule, please let your Site Coordinator know at least one week in advance.
 - **Friday Activities:** A schedule of our Friday activities will be posted on the GAP webpage as soon as we finalize the remaining dates.
 - **Pick-Up:** For pick-up every Friday, please have your ID ready. We have multiple staff members who will be assisting parents, and this helps us ensure a smooth and secure process for everyone.
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
