2026-2027 Hughes Middle School Uniform Expectations

The Long Beach Unified School District requires all students who choose to attend Hughes to wear a uniform. All student attire including footwear must adhere to LBUSD professional dress standards.

Students attending Hughes agree to the policy described below:

***School IDs must be carried at all times while on campus and provided to staff on request.**

Approved Dress Code: Hughes Colors include Navy Blue, Light or Baby Blue, Gray, or White

Bottoms:

- Navy blue pants, skirts, dresses, or shorts
- Blue jeans are acceptable (no holes, tears, rips, or cutoffs)
- All shorts, skirts, and dresses must be mid-thigh length (no short shorts, skirts, or dresses)

Tops:

- Collared or Non-collared **solid** shirts must be in school colors.
- Hughes Spirit wear is highly encouraged any day of the week
- No crop tops, tank tops, or strapless tops (even under sweatshirts)
- No inappropriate logos

Outerwear:

- Must be one solid color: white, light blue, navy, or gray
- Styles: Sweaters/sweatshirts (crew or V-neck pull-over, hoodie, cardigan), windbreakers, jackets/coats.
- Hughes Spirit sweatshirts and jackets may be worn on any school day.
- Clothing should be logo and design free.
- No hats, beanies, or hoodies on indoors (outside is ok)
- No wave caps nor bandanas
- No pajamas pants
- No slides, crocs, bubble shoes, or similar
- Shoes must be a secured shoe with closed toe

Consequences

- 1st - 2nd Step: Warning, changed out, parent notified, and clothes collected until the loaners are returned
- 3rd Step: Parent contacted, changed out, clothes collected until loaners are returned and a lunch detention
- 4th Step: Parent conference with Counselor and/or Assistant Principal
- 5th Step: Potential loss of activities and/or events for excessively not following the dress code.
