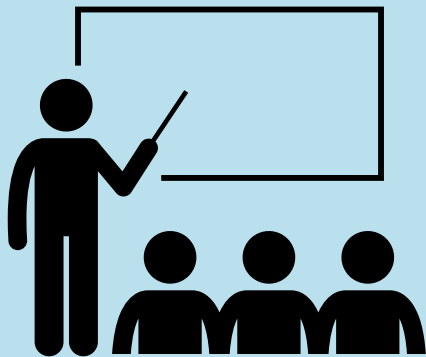
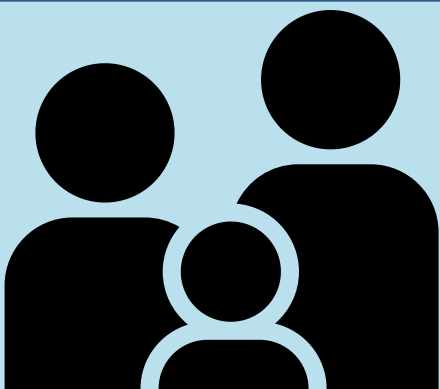


STUDENTS

Provide school-based services, including: crisis intervention, short-term individual/group counseling services, case management, resources/referrals/linkage, risk screenings, and support with home visits

PARENTS/GUARDIANS

Offer consultation, mental health and community resources, referrals for support and services, linkage to services, and parent education

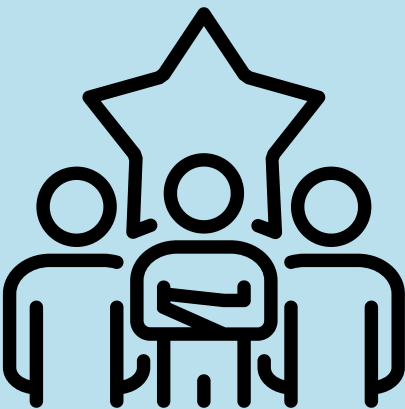


SCHOOL PERSONNEL

Work with staff to support student and staff needs (e.g., consultation, training, resources)

STUDENT SUCCESS TEAM (SST)

Actively participate in the SST process and assist in identifying and addressing barriers to learning



COLLABORATION

Work alongside other school personnel and community agencies/partners to support student/site needs

INTENSIVE STUDENT SUPPORT (ISS) PROTOCOL

Serve as Care Manager for intake and re-entry process when students are returning from hospitalization from a mental health crisis



DISTRICT-WIDE

Support with crisis response, Student Attendance Review Board (SARB), Restorative Practices trainings, and various work groups. Supervise and support Social Work Interns.

SOCIAL WORKER SUPPORT FREQUENTLY ADDRESSES

Issues impacting a child's adjustment in school, including: mental health, attendance, family dynamics, and substance use concerns
