

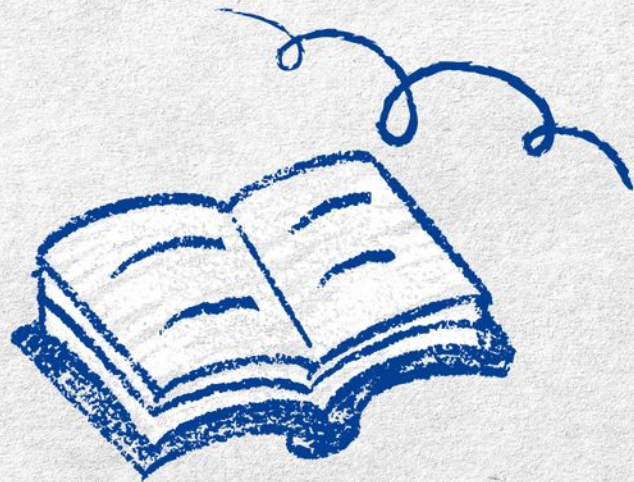

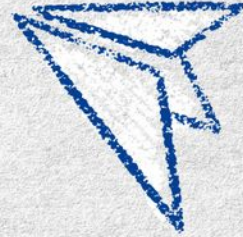

FEDERAL FUNDING TO SUPPORT ACADEMIC SUCCESS



TITLE I, Program that provides additional academic support and learning opportunities for students at schools with high percentages of socioeconomically disadvantaged children.

Program is intended to help ensure that all students meet state academic standards.



TITLE I SCHOOLWIDE (SWP) PROGRAM



DIRECT STUDENT SUPPORT

Title I provides direct instructional support to students to ensure that every student has access to an equal, fair, and high-quality education.

This program meets, at a minimum, proficiency on challenging state academic achievement standards and assessments to close academic gaps.

PROGRAM PURPOSE

Improve academic achievement throughout the school so that all students, particularly the lowest-achieving, demonstrate proficiency on State standards.

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

Provides teachers with ongoing professional development to equip them with the best evidence-based instructional and support practices.

PARENT + FAMILY ENGAGEMENT

Promotes active involvement through our PTA, SSC, and ELAC, and invites parents to volunteer directly in classroom environments.

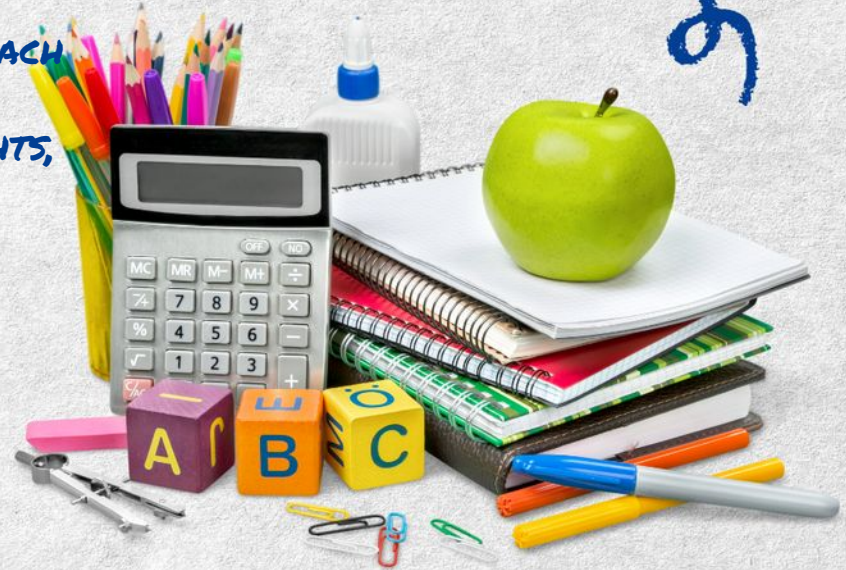
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PARENTS PARTICIPATE IN OUR PTA.

- SUPPORTS AND FUNDS FIELD TRIPS FOR STUDENTS.

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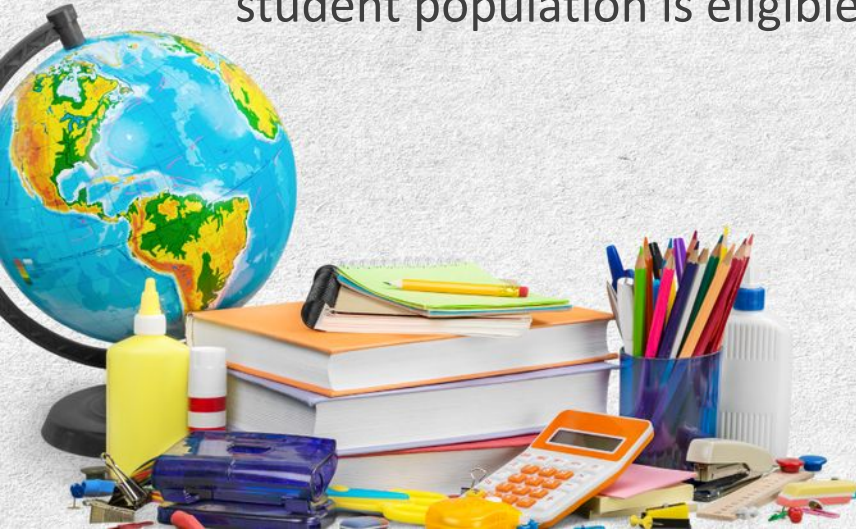


TITLE I FUNDING

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- Schools are allocated Title I funds on the basis of the percentage of students eligible for free/reduced lunch.
- Schools receive Title I funds if forty percent (40%) or more of the student population is eligible for free or reduced lunch.
