To help everyone succeed:

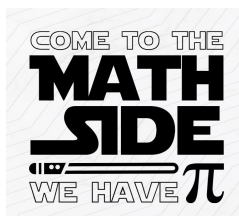
- **Be on time** and bring your materials: pencil, notebook, and computer.
