Achievement First Providence High School (PHS) is a uniform school with a clear dress code and all students are required to wear official PHS uniform items purchased from approved vendors to school each day. Uniforms are one of the ways that we create community and promote our Falcon identity. The purpose of this dress code is to remove distracting, disruptive, inappropriate, offensive, and/or unsafe clothing, footwear, and accessories from the school community.

Footwear

Students must wear closed-toed casual shoes, sneakers, or comfortable dress shoes every day.

- All footwear must be neutral or school colors (black, red, gold, gray, white).
- Slides, flip flops, slippers, furry boots, Crocs, Uggs, Birkenstocks, etc... are not allowed.



Physical Education/Dance

To ensure student comfort and safety, our Physical Education and Dance departments have a specific uniform that students should change into at the start of their scheduled PE/Dance classes. Students are required to wear sneakers for PE/Dance class. **Students are expected to change into this uniform at the start of their PE & Dance class and change back into their Monday-Thursday uniform at the end of their PE & Dance class.**

Spirit Wear

We believe in promoting an environment that displays school spirit and allows students to express their interests. As such, staff and students are allowed to dress in Spirit Wear on Early Dismissal days. This includes: PE/Dance uniform items, school-issued t-shirts/sweatshirts (Honor Roll High Flyers shirt, MayHAM shirts, Homecoming shirts, etc), and PHS Athletics attire/items. **Spirit Wear is not part of the Monday-Thursday or Dress Up Uniform attire.**

School IDs

To ensure the safety of the school building, PHS issues a school identification card & lanyard to each student at the start of the school year, and these items are part of the daily PHS school uniform. Students are expected to wear their PHS-issued ID and lanyard around their neck throughout the school day, and the student's full name and full picture must be visible at all times.

Special Attention Items

There are some clothing items which present a breach to school safety and are non-negotiable in our school building:

1. Students wearing any hat, hood, or sunglasses will be directed to remove the item, as these items pose a large risk to a student's individual safety (seizures, illicit drug use, etc...) and to the feeling of safety that our school provides to other students.
2. Students are not allowed to wear non-PHS outerwear. This includes any sweater, sweatshirt, jacket, etc... without a PHS logo.
