- Something that makes you feel unsafe or uncomfortable.

TEASING OR HARASSING

- When do jokes stop being funny and start being mean?
- We **never** tease someone about anything that is part of who they are as a person.
 - Race or Ethnic Background
 - Religion or Beliefs
 - Gender
 - Sexual Orientation
 - Disability
 - Body type or physical features
