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Media Release: Community Eligibility Provision (CEP)

The San Marcos CISD Child Nutrition Department and San Marcos High School, San Marcos Excel Academy, Goodnight Middle School, Miller Middle School, Bowie Elementary, Crockett Elementary, DeZavala Elementary, Travis Elementary, Hernandez Elementary, Mendez Elementary, Rodriguez Elementary and Bonham PreK announced today it will operate the Community Eligibility Program (CEP) under the National School Lunch Program and School Breakfast Program for the 2026-2027 school year. Schools qualifying to operate CEP serve breakfast and lunch to all children at no charge and eliminate the collection of meal applications for free, reduced-price, and paid student meals. This approach reduces burdens for both families and school administrators and helps ensure that students receive nutritious meals.
