| Thursday, Sept. 10 | Candidate speeches given during Advisory, followed by elections. Election results posted outside of the Student Center by 3:45. All campaign materials must be removed from campus by 4:00 pm. |

CLASS REPRESENTATIVE RESPONSIBILITIES

(Requirement - minimum 2.5 unweighted GPA)

9th grade will have 5 Representatives; 10th will have 3 Reps; 11th and 12th will have 4 Reps.

- Represent their class's interests to high school student council
- Periodically report back to class on student council plans and decisions
- Officiate occasional meetings during class advisory meetings
- Attend all student council events and assist with planning, set-up, and clean-up.
- Serve on a Committee (either Dance, Activities, Communications, Fundraising, or Assembly), headed by a Student Council officer.

Student Council Members understand that they must set a good example for the rest of the student body. They abide by all school rules and policies including those listed in the Oakwood Student Handbook, HSSC Bylaws, and the following election expectations:

1. Students are only allowed to campaign from Tuesday, Sept. 8 to Thursday, Sept. 10.
2. Posters may be placed anywhere on the high school campus, but may only be hung with painter's tape (blue), and may not be hung on the lockers or in bathrooms.
3. Candidates will not put down any other candidate in any of their campaign materials or speeches. Doing so may result in the candidate's name being removed from the ballot.
4. Food, prizes, or other such "bribes" may NOT be handed out. Buttons are allowed.
5. All posters must be taken down following the election by 4pm on Thursday, Sep. 10.
