Facilities Update

Summer is always a busy season in Copley-Fairlawn City Schools, as our maintenance and operations teams work behind the scenes to prepare our buildings and grounds for another successful school year. Their efforts help ensure our students and staff return to clean, safe, and welcoming learning environments each August.

This summer, projects across the district included:

- Routine maintenance, deep cleaning, and fresh painting throughout our buildings
- Parking lot expansion and resurfacing projects
- New and refreshed landscaping at several campuses
- Construction of a new restroom and storage facility near the tennis courts and athletic fields at Copley High School

Our commitment to improving district facilities continues beyond the summer months. This fall, work will begin on a renovation of the Copley High School Natatorium/Main Gym entrance. The updated entrance will complement the design of the high school's main entrance while providing a more visible, welcoming, and functional entry for spectators attending athletic events and community activities.



We are also excited to share that the design for the new Copley-Fairlawn Middle School band room has been finalized. This project will create a dedicated, safe, and modern learning space for our middle school instrumental music students and their directors. We anticipate breaking ground before the end of the calendar year and look forward to sharing updates as construction progresses.

Thank you to our maintenance, custodial, and grounds crews for the tremendous work they do each summer to care for our facilities and create spaces where students can learn, perform, compete, and thrive.
