

Grade 11 Choice Ready Checklist

- ☐ Show up - aim for 95% attendance (don't miss class more than 3x/semester)
- ☐ Pass another 12 classes to earn another 6 credits. You should have 18 credits by the end of your junior year. If you are not on track, come up with a credit recovery plan with your counselor!
- ☐ Strive to maintain a 2.8+ GPA as classes get harder (this means you try to get at least an A or B in most classes)
- ☐ Update your 4-year plan (you will do this in your advisory class!)
- ☐ Document your involvement and accomplishments in your Choice Ready Dashboard (you will do this in your advisory class!)
- ☐ Take on leadership roles in sports and activities (Prom Committee, NHS, WFHS Ambassadors, etc.). If you aren't a part of any school activity, join something!
- ☐ Get a job on weekends, after school, or in the summertime

- ☐ Serve AT LEAST FIVE MORE volunteer hours (for a total of 15)

- ☐ Prepare for the ASVAB and strive for a score of 31+ (taken the week of April 12)
- ☐ Prepare for the ACT and strive for a composite score of 24+ (WFPS Test Date: April 10, 2027)
- ☐ Take a SECOND CTE class to explore a field or area of interest! The goal is to have completed at least 3 CTE courses before you graduate!
- ☐ Maintain quality citizenship (no suspensions)
- ☐ Complete the statewide cybersecurity requirement (you will do this in your advisory class!)
- ☐ Finish a third year of fine arts OR world languages with a C or above!
- ☐ Take Algebra 2 and earn at least a C
- ☐ Challenge yourself with an Advanced Placement or Dual Credit course! Strive to earn a C or above or score at least a 3 on the AP exam! ([what's the difference between AP and DC courses?](#))
