This Contract is designed for community health services at the Mineral County School District for the 2026/2027 school year.

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3. Recommendation: Discussion and Possible Approval of the Purchase of Two (2) Multipurpose Passenger Vehicles (MPVs) for Student Transportation.

Supporting Information: To purchase two (2) Multipurpose Passenger Vehicles (MPVs), each originally manufactured and designed to transport no more than ten (10) occupants, including the driver, in addition to the Mineral County School District transportation fleet. The vehicles will supplement the District's existing school bus fleet and provide additional transportation options for small groups of students when the use of a school bus is not practical or when a qualified school bus driver is unavailable to meet the District's transportation needs. Uses may include transportation associated with the District's rural and remote service areas and transportation to approved school-sponsored activities and athletic events. Vehicles will be purchased and operated in accordance with applicable federal and Nevada law, District policy, insurance requirements, and applicable vehicle and driver safety requirements.

Budget Consideration: Not to exceed \$57,652 from General Fund and Capital Improvement Funds
