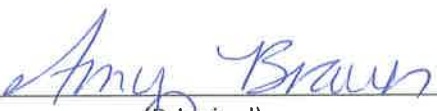
- Scientifically research-based curriculum will be used

- Progress monitoring will be ongoing

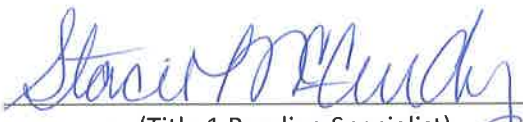

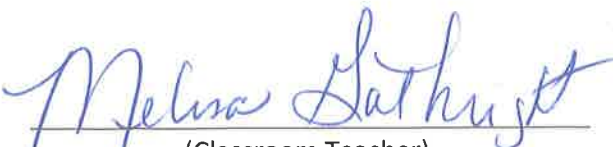

Parents will be offered descriptions and explanations of the school's curriculum, forms of academic assessment used to measure children's progress and the proficiency levels students are expected to meet.

Northmoor will provide opportunities for parents to volunteer at the school during parties, library activities, and Title I events, and meetings. Parents will be involved in other ways in an organized, ongoing, and timely way, with the result being parent involvement that is meaningful. At the request of parents, opportunities will be provided for meetings with teachers to formulate suggestions for participation, as appropriate, in decisions about the education of their children.
