The Senior Dining Meal Program is offered as a service through the Dodge County Human Services and Health Department's Aging and Disability Resource Center of Dodge County.

Our **Senior Dining Centers** give older adults a place to enjoy a fresh, healthy meal with others. Centers offer a space for community and companionship. Meals are offered five days a week at dining centers located throughout Dodge County.

Meal Reservations

We'd love to have you join us for a meal. Please call your dining center to reserve your spot at least 48 hours in advance, before 12:00 pm. On your first visit, our Dining Center Coordinator will complete a quick eligibility check so we can begin serving you.

Meal Cost

Based on federal requirements of the Older Americans Act, participants are encouraged to make a voluntary contribution towards the cost of the meal. *No participant will be denied a meal if they are unable to contribute.*

Menus

The Senior Dining Program menus are listed weekly in local newspapers as well as being announced daily on the following radio stations: 1430AM WBEV, 1540AM WTKM, 95.3FM WBEV, 104.9 FM WTKM. You can also find the menu posted at each dining center location or on our website.

Volunteers

Volunteers play an important role in supporting our dining sites. If you'd like to help our Dining Site Coordinators with a variety of tasks, we'd be glad to hear from you. Please contact the Aging and Disability Resource Center of Dodge County to learn more.

Days of Operation

The Senior Dining Program operates Monday through Friday during the lunch hour with the *exception* of the following holidays:

- New Year's Day,
- Spring Holiday (Friday before Easter),
- Memorial Day,
- 4th of July,
- Labor Day,
- Thanksgiving,
- Day after Thanksgiving,
- Christmas Eve,
- Christmas Day, and
- New Year's Eve.

The Senior Dining Program is **CANCELED** when weather conditions make travel hazardous. Please monitor local radio and TV stations or visit our Facebook page during inclement weather to check for cancellations.
