

Extra Support with Medicare Drug Coverage

A benefit program attached to a Medicare Part D plan that reduces some or all of your prescription costs. Such as premium and deductible copays.

You may qualify if your income and assets fall within these limits:

For an Individual:

- Gross monthly income under \$1,995
- Assets below \$16,590
**Some assets may be excluded*

For a Couple:

- Gross monthly income under \$2,705
- Assets below \$33,100
**Some assets may be excluded*

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Medicare Cost-Saving Programs



The Medicare Savings Program (MSP)

The Medicare Savings Program helps people with limited income pay for Medicare. If you qualify, Wisconsin may cover your Medicare Part B premium—potentially saving you more than \$2,434 each year.

You may qualify if your income and assets fall within these limits:

For an Individual:

- Gross monthly income under \$1,995
- Assets below \$16,590
**Some assets may be excluded*

For a Couple:

- Gross monthly income is under \$2,705
- Assets below \$33,100
**Some assets may be excluded*

Extra Help: Medicare's Low-Income Subsidy

Low-Income Subsidy is a Medicare program that helps people with limited income and resources pay for their prescription drug costs. It reduces what you pay for copays, deductibles, and premiums under Medicare Part D, making your medications more affordable.

SeniorCare

A program that makes prescriptions and vaccines more affordable for older adults.

To qualify for SeniorCare, you must be:

- 65 years of age or older
- A Wisconsin resident
- A U.S. citizen or qualifying immigrant
- Able to pay a \$30 annual enrollment fee per individual

*There are no asset limits to enroll.

Your annual out-of-pocket costs are based on your yearly income. Depending on your income, you may have to meet a deductible, then you'll pay \$5 for generic prescriptions and \$15 for brand-name prescriptions.

SeniorCare is creditable coverage for Medicare Part D, and it can be used alongside a Part D plan.
