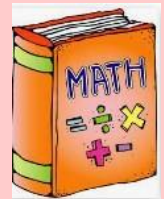
Homework will be assigned daily, some exceptions for Friday. Missing work or incomplete classwork will need to be completed at home.

Materials Needed Each Day

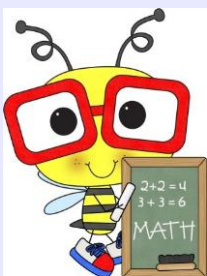
- PENCILS
