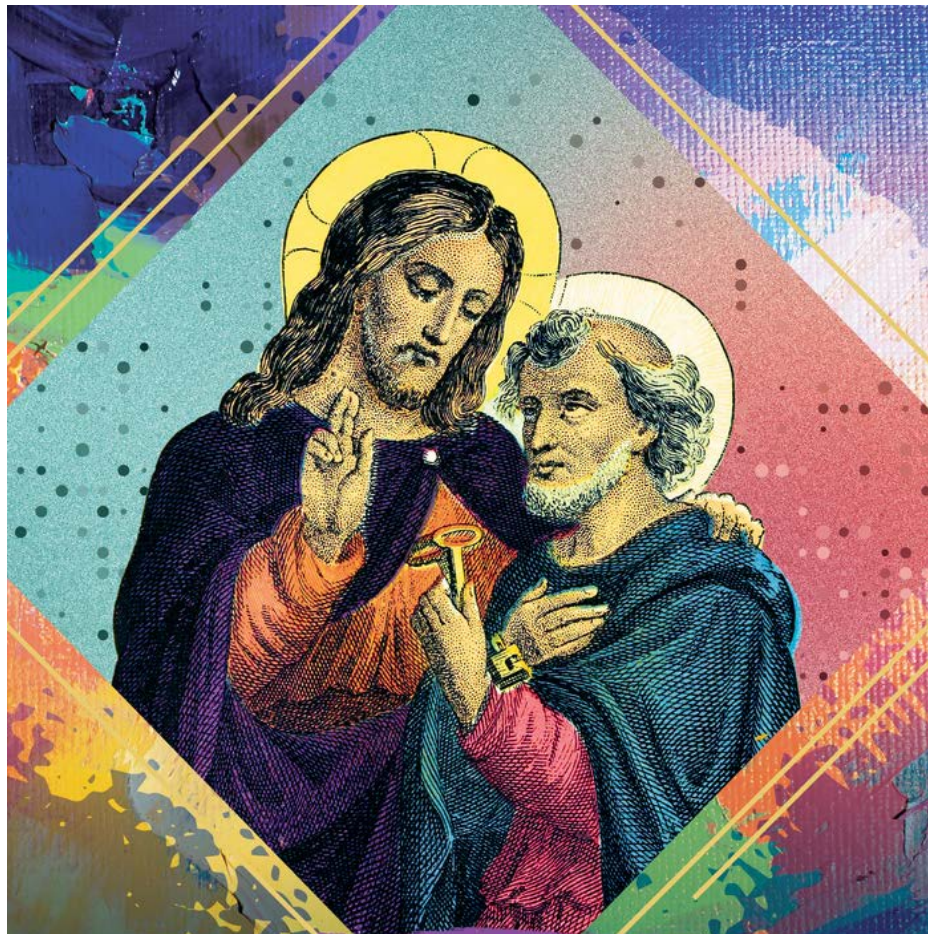

A word from Seminarian Jonathan Ligenza

We all know the saying: "You can't leave now; the party is just getting started." Unfortunately, it is time for me to say, "See you soon." I am returning to Sacred Heart Major Seminary for the upcoming school year. I would like to express my gratitude to Fathers Bob, Dan, and Ryan for allowing me to experience daily life as a priest here at Divine Child. I will cherish the memories I have made and the many lessons I learned during this past month as I begin my studies in Theology. I am also deeply grateful to the parishioners of Divine Child for your strong faith and devotion. Your example has been a blessing to me. Please know that I will keep you in my prayers throughout the coming school year.

I would also like to share a significant step in my vocation that took place recently. On August 12th, I received the Rite of Admission to Candidacy. For those who may be wondering, "What is Candidacy?" Candidacy is the Church's formal recognition that a seminarian has discerned a sincere intention to continue preparing for Holy Orders and has demonstrated the qualities necessary to advance in formation. In the rite, the Church publicly receives the candidate's intention to continue this preparation. During the rite, Archbishop Weisenburger asked me the following questions: "In response to the Lord's call, do you resolve to complete your preparation so that in due time, through Holy Orders, you will be prepared to assume ministry within the Church?" "Do you resolve to prepare yourself in mind and spirit to give faithful service to Christ the Lord and his Body, the Church?" To both questions, I responded with the words: "I do." These words marked an important turning point in my vocation not because Candidacy is ordination, but because it represents a deeper and more intentional commitment to continue preparing for the Holy Priesthood of Jesus Christ. With this new focus, I am called to configure my heart more fully to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus and to the demands of His Holy Priesthood. The Church understands priestly formation as a gradual process involving human, spiritual, intellectual, and pastoral growth.

After receiving Candidacy, I will be able to wear clerics for the first time. This external sign reminds me and others that my life is being configured more intentionally toward Christ and His Church. This does not mean I am ordained yet. The plan is for me to complete approximately three and a half years of graduate theological education. During the fourth year, God willing, I will be ordained a transitional deacon during Advent. I will then serve as a deacon in a parish for six months before, God willing, being ordained to the priesthood.

As Blessed Solanus Casey said repeatedly, "Thank God ahead of time for all His blessings and designs." Blessed Solanus's life was marked by humility, trust, and faithful service to Christ and to those most in need. I echo that same prayer today. I thank God ahead of time for the blessings He has already given me throughout my life and especially for the blessing of this summer at Divine Child.

Thank you for welcoming me, encouraging me, and allowing me to share in the life of this parish. Please keep me in your prayers as I return to the seminary, and know that I will continue to pray for all of you.

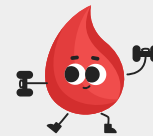

HOW TO IMPROVE YOUR BLOOD DONATION EXPERIENCE...

Hemoglobin is a protein in your body that contains iron and carries oxygen to the tissues in your body. To improve the chance that your **hemoglobin level** is adequate to donate blood, consider the following tips:

- **Eat a nutritious, well-balanced diet daily with foods rich in iron and high in vitamin C.** Iron rich foods include red meat, fish, poultry, eggs, beans, lentils, spinach, and dried fruit such as raisins. Vitamin C helps with the absorption of iron. Foods high in vitamin C include bell peppers, tomatoes, broccoli, kiwi, strawberries, oranges, and other citrus fruits.
- Get a good night's sleep the night before your donation. Drink extra fluids and eat a healthy meal on the day of your donation. It is suggested to drink an extra 16 ounces of water before your appointment.

After your donation:

- Relax and recover with juice and snacks in the refreshment area.
- Drink an extra four (8 oz.) glasses of non-alcoholic liquids over the next 24 hours.
- Keep eating iron rich foods.
- If you donate frequently, be sure to take multivitamins with iron to ensure you continue to replenish your iron stores before your next donation.

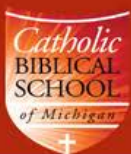

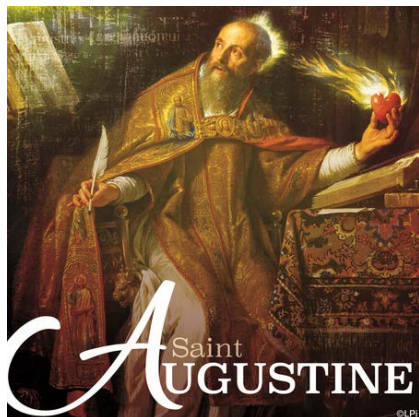

Tuesday, August 25 is our Parish Day of Prayer for Vocations to the Priesthood and Religious Life

Divine Child Parish designates the fourth Tuesday of every month as a day of prayer for vocations before the Blessed Sacrament.

Every 4th Tuesday we pray for religious vocations. A Plenary Indulgence can be obtained through praying in front of the Blessed Sacrament.

To obtain an Indulgence, a person must attend Confession and Communion within 8 days (either side) of the indulgenced act or prayer and pray for the Holy Father's intentions (traditionally one Our Father and one Hail Mary). In addition, to obtain a Plenary Indulgence, one must be completely detached from one's sins, even venial sins. If one does not have complete detachment, then the Indulgence is only partial.

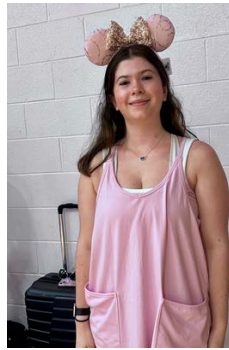

GOSPEL MEDITATION

August 23, 2026

Twenty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time

Matthew 16:13-20

The first time I stood inside St. Peter's Basilica in Rome, its majesty overwhelmed me. The sheer beauty of Michelangelo's dome seemed to lift my soul right out of my body. Later, I joined the Scavi tour that winds below the basilica, down into the ancient pagan cemetery where Peter was buried. There, in the dim light and narrow passageways, I found myself looking at the bones of a murdered Jewish fisherman, his feet cut off so his crucified body could be taken down more easily.

What a paradox. Above me, the most glorious church ever built. Beneath me, the remains of a backwater fisherman. But this man dared to answer Jesus' question, "Who do you say that I am?" And crowning that immense dome above his tomb are the words from today's Gospel, "You are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my Church."

Within you and me is the drama of the lowest and the highest. Every time we confess Christ, humbly, imperfectly, maybe even trembling, we enter that same mystery. The dust of our humanity, touched by the splendor of heaven. God's presence and our dry bones together. Humility and glory. May our lives embrace both the lowest and the highest, like that great basilica, as we profess Jesus.

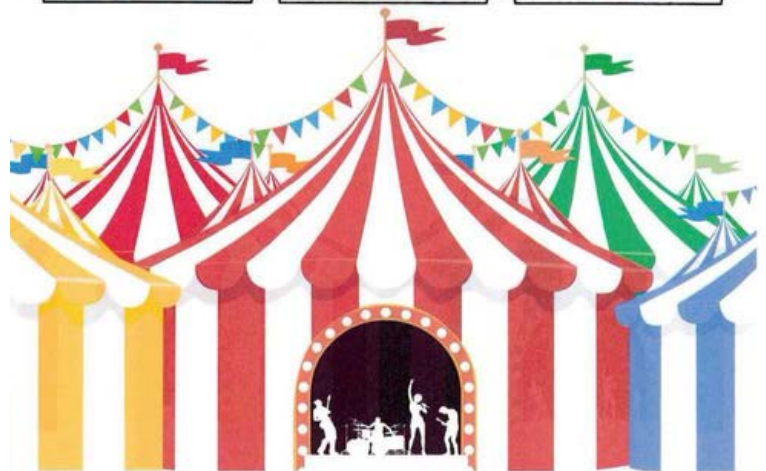

Right to Life - LIFESPAN Play Pickleball to Support Life

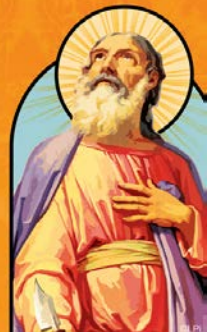
