2026-2027 Midland ISD Stadium and Athletic Event Rules

Dear Parent,

Support for both Midland High School and Midland Legacy High School Friday night activities has been tremendous! In fact, the attendance at Astound Broadband Stadium has exceeded our expectations. We wish to create an environment in which all spectators, season ticket holders, students and families with children of all ages may enjoy the game. We also want to ensure the safety of our guests by implementing the following guidelines:

- All students 8th grade and below are required to be accompanied by a parent in order to attend home Varsity football games. Parents and their children may bring school age guests. Please be advised that you are responsible for the school age guests accompanying you to the game as well as your own children.
- Elementary school students are expected to sit with their parents at all times. Elementary students are prohibited from loitering and running through the main concourse and handicap areas.
- Junior High school students must enter the stadium through Gate 2 with a parent. Junior High students are required to either sit with their parents or sit in the junior high section of the stadium, which is section 101 on the Northwest end of the stadium.
- High school students must enter the stadium through Gate 1 and must show a student ID in order to enter the stadium. High school students will be required to use the restrooms and concession stand also at Gate 1. High school students not sitting with their parents must sit in high school sections 108, 109 or 208. High school students from another school must be accompanied by their parents or sit on the visitors side.
- Students are expected to be picked up no later than 30 minutes after the end of any athletic event. Failure to pick up students within the 30 minute grace period may result in students being restricted from attending future athletic events. Any student still at the athletic event after the 30 minute grace period may be issued a loitering ticket and may be prevented from attending any other athletic events.

Failure to follow these guidelines or loitering by students may result in removal from the stadium and at a minimum, the student will not be allowed to attend any further high school football games for the season.

As always, student safety at all UIL events is of the utmost importance to Midland ISD. Athletic events are spectator sports and all students attending the games are expected to sit and watch the game. These measures will help all of us enjoy our MISD hosted event and to cheer our teams on to victory.
