Orientation for Kindergarten will be on September 2, 2026, at 2:00 p.m. We will be meeting on the black top outside of Timber Point by the playground and be walking in by class. **The Parent Portal will open for all First and Second grade students on August 27th after 11:00 a.m. At that time, you will be able to view your child's class placement for this school year.** Enclosed you will find a classroom tag for your child. Please have them wear it for the first few weeks of school.
