TEEN INFLUENCERS

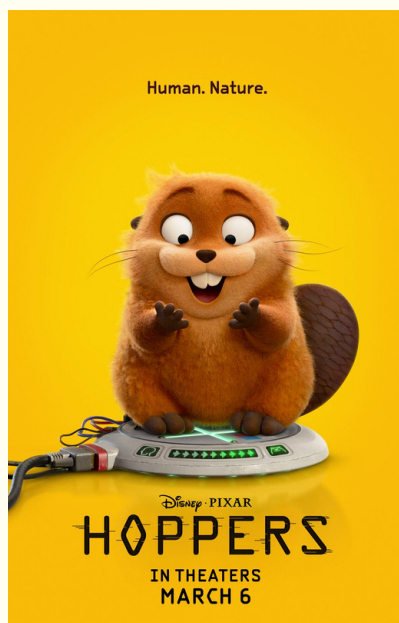
Teens (ages 14-16) will **earn volunteer hours** by influencing the library! Enjoy snacks, plan teen events, recommend books, and more. Please register.
