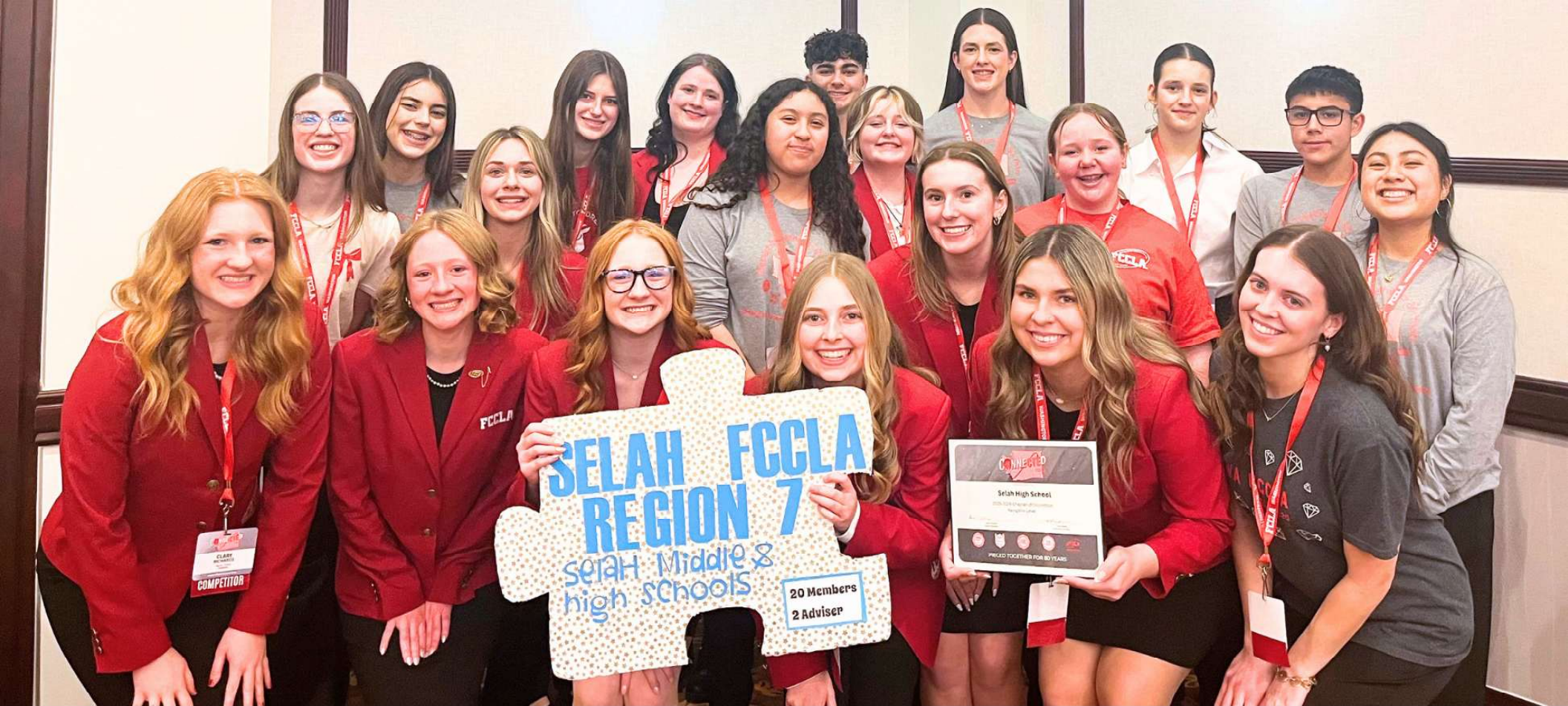

• Title I Schools: Request for Public Records

If you are a parent of a student at a school that receives Title I funds, you have the right to know the professional qualifications of the classroom teachers who instruct your child. Federal law allows you to ask for certain information about your child's classroom teachers, and requires us to give you this information in a timely manner if you ask for it. Specifically, you have the right to ask for the following information about each of your child's classroom teachers:

*Whether the Office of the Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI) has licensed or qualified the teacher for the grades and subjects he or she teaches.

*Whether OSPI has decided the teacher can teach in a classroom without being licensed or qualified under state regulations because of special circumstances that have caused OSPI to waive the licensing or qualification criteria.

*The teacher's college major; whether the teacher has any advanced degrees and, if so, the subject of the degrees.

*Whether any teachers' aides or similar paraprofessionals provide services to your child and, if they do, their qualifications.

Schools in the Selah School District that receive Title I funds are: John Campbell Primary, Selah Intermediate School, Selah Middle School, and Selah High School. Title I under the Every Child Succeeds Act (ESSA) federal law distributes funding to schools with a high percentage of students from low-income families.

• Standard Tort Claim

Washington state law (Chapter 4.92 RCW) requires a Standard Tort Claim Form to be submitted when filing a tort claim against the Selah School District.

Standard Tort Claim forms cannot be submitted electronically (via e-mail or fax) but must be mailed or delivered to the address noted in the forms packet.

• Harassment, Intimidation, or Bullying

Selah School District is committed to a safe and civil educational environment for all students, employees, volunteers and patrons, free from harassment, intimidation, or bullying.

In accordance with District Policy 3207 and Procedure 3207, all reports of bullying, harassment, and/or intimidation will be taken seriously and investigated.

• Sexual Harassment

• Possession of Firearms

The possession of firearms on Selah School District property will result in a one year

mandatory expulsion, subject to appeal with notification to parents and law enforcement. (RCW 28A.600.420).

• Controlled Substances

The Selah School District has no tolerance for controlled substances, drugs, alcohol, or look-a-likes. Any student, staff member, parent, or patron found to be in possession will be disciplined and/or prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law. Further, appropriate school disciplinary action will be taken regardless of law enforcement action. Parents/guardians are advised your child(ren) receive a Student Handbook which explains disciplinary procedures and possible consequences. Please review these materials with your child(ren).

• Surplus District Property

At least once each year, the district advertises the sale of "surplus" school equipment. This may include such items as worn or outdated computer equipment, furniture, books, sporting equipment or musical instruments. These used items are offered for sale at used prices - first to students, other private or public schools, and non-profit organizations supporting young people, then to the public.

All immunization records turned in to schools or child care centers are required by state law to be medically verified. Immunization records must be turned into the school on or before the first day of attendance. This means immunization records turned in to the school must be from a health care provider, or you must attach paperwork from a health care provider to your handwritten form that shows your child's records are accurate. Your child cannot attend school until you provide these records. Please contact your school office or one of the Selah School District nurses with questions.
